The trustees who are also directors of the charity for the purposes of the Companies Act 2006, present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 March 2023. OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

- * The Church was established to advance the Christian Belief in accordance with the statement of believes as contained in the Memorandum and Articles of The Elim Pentecostal Church, Pontyates.
- * The Church has been operating in the village of Pontyates, in the borough of Llanelli and has at present no full time of part time employees.
- * With the general restriction posed due to the pandemic, no meetings of any form took place until the 30th May 2022.
- * Outside speakers are usually invited by The Church Leader to minister at the various services. No payment is made for these services other than the reimbursement of travel expenses.

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

The following activities are usually undertaken:-

Weekly Divine Worship, Bible teaching and Ministry Meetings have been severely curtailed.

The Minister of The Cavalry Church Haverfordwest (Rev A Vaughn) who was previously available to assist in spiritual matters, if required is now further assisting Elim Pentecostal Church by providing speakers for the Sunday afternoon services. This has established a closer link between both Churches.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2023

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charitable company, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
