

MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

- 1 The Company's name is ICON EAST MIDLANDS ("ICON EAST MIDLANDS")
- 2 ICON EAST MIDLANDS's registered office is to be situated in England and Wales
- 3 ICON EAST MIDLANDS's objects ("the Objects") are to benefit in a wholly charitable manner people that live or work within the geography comprised within the area of responsibility of the East Midlands Development Agency by

undertaking, commissioning and supporting research including innovation in areas of science, engineering, information technology, management, economics, sustainability, the environment and aesthetics associated with the built and wider environment, including its processes and artefacts,

promoting education and community benefit, in all such matters, and being a catalyst for collecting, collating and publishing useful information, ideas, and data relating to such matters

- In furtherence of the Objects and to the extent the directors of ICON EAST MIDLANDS shall from time to time determine ICON EAST MIDLANDS may,
 - 3 1 1 promote and encourage the achievement and maintenance of high standards by organisations and individuals in the environments they create and maintain,
 - 3 1 2 provide expert advice and assistance,

- 3 1 3 promote and encourage the exchange of knowledge, information and services,
- 3 1 4 promote cost effective and sustainable environmental and economic wellbeing,
- 3 1 5 foster and promote the formation and operation of any consultative, advisory, or other committees, whether of a national, regional or local nature, which in the opinion of ICON EAST MIDLANDS may be of assistance in furtherence of the Objects,
- 3 1 6 provide, and otherwise foster support and assist, educational services,
- 3 1 7 support and assist in the implementation of any national, regional or local scheme for the development of the use of information and communication technologies which in the opinion of ICON EAST MIDLANDS may be of benefit in furtherence of the Objects,
- 3 1 8 foster, support and assist in relevant strategic development at national, regional or local level,
- 3 1 9 procure to be prepared, printed, published, issued and disseminated any programme, recording, pamphlet, periodical, book, document or other work and to fix, make and receive fees, royalties and other charges therefore,
- 3 1 10 hold exhibitions, meetings, seminars, conferences, displays, courses and other activities either alone or with others and to fix, make and receive fees and other charges in respect of any such services,
- 3 1 11 provide advice as a consultancy, make grants and determine, pay or receive fees and other charges in respect of any service, goods or utilities,
- 3 1 12 purchase or otherwise acquire, lease or otherwise have the use of, sell or dispose of any interest or use of any tangible or intangible asset including without limitation equipment including computer hardware and software, furniture, fixtures, fittings and all other chattels and effects of every description and to apply for and maintain the registration of any patents, rights, copyrights, licences and the like,

- 3 1 13 issue appeals, hold meetings and take such other steps as may be required for or conducive to the purpose of applying for and procuring contributions to the funds of ICON EAST MIDLANDS.
- 3 1 14 support or undertake innovation in and commitment to the built environment and relevant information and communications technology based and traditionally based service delivery and products,
- 3 1 15 promote and disseminate knowledge of and by use of information and communications technology and by traditional means,
- In furtherence of the Objects ICON EAST MIDLANDS shall work as a regional agency principally, but not exclusively, for and with,
 - 3 2 1 East Midlands Development Agency,
 - 3 2 2 West Northants Development Corporation,
 - 3 2 3 East Midlands Centre for constructing the Built Environment,
 - 3 2 4 universities,
 - 3 2 5 local authorities,
 - 3 2 6 other agencies and organisations in the public and charitable Sectors,
 - 3 2 7 government departments and agencies and any body promoted by one or more of them, and
 - 3 2 8 other persons and other organisations, including commercial concerns, as the directors of ICON EAST MIDLANDS shall from time to time approve or specify either specifically or more generally,
- In furtherence of the Objects and to the extent and in such manner as the directors of ICON EAST MIDLANDS shall from time to time determine ICON EAST MIDLANDS shall promote,
 - 3 3 1 innovation, sustainability, efficiency, utility, visual amenity, good design and effective functional delivery in the built environment including without limitation construction, communications, transport, reuse and recycling of waste and the production of and effective use of energy,

- 3 3 2 conservation of natural resources, respect for and nurture of the environment, the wellbeing of people, flora and fauna and economic endeavours and outcomes that are effective, appropriate and beneficial, and
- 3 3 3 greater awareness of the built environment, of desirable innovations within it and how best to research, develop and implement these
- In furtherance of the Objects but not otherwise ICON EAST MIDLANDS may exercise the following powers
 - 4 1 to issue bills, cheques and other instruments and to operate bank accounts in the name of ICON EAST MIDLANDS,
 - 4 2 to raise funds, enter into grant agreements, to invite and receive contributions and to receive gifts subject to special trusts within the Objects, without prejudice to ICON EAST MIDLANDS having the right to refuse as it sees fit any grant, gift, contribution, legacy or bequest and provided that in raising funds by way of gift ICON EAST MIDLANDS shall conform to any relevant statutory regulations,
 - 4 3 to acquire, alter, improve, occupy, lease, licence the use of and (subject to such consents as may be required by law) to change or otherwise dispose of land and other property, and to borrow money whether upon security or otherwise,
 - 4.4 to invest any moneys not for the time being required for ICON EAST MIDLANDS's general purposes or with a view to meeting long term commitments or requirements and to hold (either in nominee names or otherwise) sell or otherwise deal in such investments (either under discretionary investment management arrangements or otherwise) and generally to do all things which are in ICON EAST MIDLANDS's best interests or which are calculated directly or indirectly to protect, enhance the value of, or use most efficiently ICON EAST MIDLANDS's assets or resources,
 - 4.5 subject to clause 6 of this Memorandum and the Articles of Association of ICON EAST MIDLANDS to accept, agree or contract for goods, utilities, services, service, assistance or contributions of any person or organisation

upon such terms as ICON EAST MIDLANDS may see fit including the provisions of remuneration, indemnities, reimbursement of expenses, insurance and reasonable working conditions, and to provide reasonable terms of employment including benefits for past employees and the dependants of employees,

- to pay out of the funds of ICON EAST MIDLANDS the cost of any premium in respect of insurance or indemnities to cover the liability of the directors, officers, employees, secondees or auditors of ICON EAST MIDLANDS (or any of them) which by virtue of any rule of law would otherwise attach to them or any of them in respect of any negligence, default, breach of duty or breach of trust of which they may be guilty in relation to ICON EAST MIDLANDS, provided that any such insurance shall not provide cover for any director of ICON EAST MIDLANDS against any claim arising from any act or omission which that director knew was a breach of trust or fiduciary duty or which was committed by that director in reckless disregard of whether it was a breach of trust or not.
- 4 7 to establish or support by any means including the making of grants or loans to any trusts, associations, corporations or institutions formed for all or any of the Objects,
- 48 to co-operate with universities and university colleges, other educational establishments, charities, voluntary bodies, statutory authorities and other persons and associations operating in furtherance of the Objects or any of them or similar charitable purposes and to assist them and exchange information and advice with them,
- 4 9 to pay and reimburse out of the funds of ICON EAST MIDLANDS the costs, charges and expenses of and incidental to the formation and registration of ICON EAST MIDLANDS.
- 4 10 to make charges, including nominal or no charges, in respect of any of the activities of the ICON EAST MIDLANDS.
- 4 11 to subscribe for, take, purchase, or otherwise acquire and hold shares, stock or other interests in or obligations of any other company or corporation and enter into contacts or grant agreements with same, and

- 4 12 to do all such other lawful things as are necessary, desirable or convenient for the furtherance or achievement of the Objects or any of them
- The income and property of ICON EAST MIDLANDS shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the Objects and no part shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, other distribution, bonus or otherwise by way of profit, to members of ICON EAST MIDLANDS, and no director of ICON EAST MIDLANDS shall be appointed to any office of ICON EAST MIDLANDS paid by salary or fees or receive any remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth from ICON EAST MIDLANDS save that nothing in this document shall prevent any payment in good faith by ICON EAST MIDLANDS
 - Payment of commensurate remuneration and provision of sufficient benefits to any chief executive or chair of the directors if and to the extent there is any necessary prior written approval of the Charity Commission, provided that at no time shall a majority of the directors benefit under this provision and that a director shall withdraw from any meeting at which their appointment or remuneration, is under discussion,
 - of the usual professional charges for business done by any director who is a solicitor, accountant or other person engaged in a profession, or by any business partner of any director, when instructed by ICON EAST MIDLANDS to act in a professional capacity on its behalf, provided that at no time shall a majority of the directors benefit under this provision and that a director shall withdraw from any meeting at which their appointment or remuneration or that of their business partner, is under discussion,
 - of reasonable and proper remuneration for any services rendered to ICON EAST MIDLANDS by any officer or servant of ICON EAST MIDLANDS or individual seconded to ICON EAST MIDLANDS by a member who is not a director of ICON EAST MIDLANDS.
 - of interest on money lent by any member or director of ICON EAST MIDLANDS at a reasonable and proper rate per annum not exceeding a figure less than the published base lending rate of a clearing bank both to be selected unanimously by the members,

- of fees, remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth to either any company, other corporation, partnership, other person or association of which a director or office holder or employee of a member, officer or employee provided that such membership, office or employment is disclosed to ICON EAST MIDLANDS, the relevant contractual terms are fully disclosed to the members and the members unanimously agree, either as a matter of general policy or in any specific case, subject to such terms as they may from time to time require,
- of reasonable and proper rent for premises demised or let by any member or director of ICON EAST MIDLANDS.
- 5 7 of reasonable and proper premiums in respect of indemnity insurance,
- 5 8 to any director of reasonable out of pocket expenses
- 6 The liability of the members of ICON EAST MIDLANDS is limited
 - Every member of ICON EAST MIDLANDS undertakes to that it or some other person shall or has agreed to contribute such amount or thing as may be required (to a value not exceeding £1) to ICON EAST MIDLANDS's assets if it should be wound up whilst a member or within one year after ceasing to be a member, for payment of ICON EAST MIDLANDS's debts and liabilities contracted before cessation of membership and of the costs, charges and expenses of winding up, and for the adjustment of the rights of the contributors among themselves
 - If ICON EAST MIDLANDS is wound up or dissolved and after all its debts and liabilities have been satisfied there remains any property it shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of ICON EAST MIDLANDS, but shall be given or transferred to some person or persons, having objects similar to or which encompass the Objects and which prohibit the distribution of assets and income and is or are by law prohibited from such distributions to an extent at least as great as imposed on ICON EAST MIDLANDS by this memorandum of association, chosen by the members of ICON EAST MIDLANDS at or before the time of dissolution and if that cannot be done then to some other object of public benefit

- Subject to any consent of the Charity Commission required by law, this memorandum of association and the articles of association of ICON EAST MIDLANDS shall not be altered or varied, save where the members determine that an alteration or variation shall be made pursuant to a resolution by them at a general meeting at which at least two thirds of the members are present or in writing and where at least a half of the members are in favour. No business shall be undertaken by ICON EAST MIDLANDS other than in the furtherance of the Objects and ICON EAST MIDLANDS shall neither borrow moneys nor enter into commitments in excess of the funds or realisable asset value, which ICON EAST MIDLANDS has to repay such moneys or meet such commitments
- 6 4 ICON EAST MIDLANDS shall not guarantee the liabilities of or indemnify any person save as provided for specifically by this memorandum of association or by the articles of association of ICON EAST MIDLANDS and then only to the extent necessary to enable proper furtherance of the Objects

1 1 In these Articles

1

"ICON EAST MIDLANDS" means the company intended to be regulated by these Articles,

- "Advisory Group" means an advisory group established under Article 19 of these Articles,
- -"Act" means the Companies Acts 1985 and 1989 and the Companies Act 2006 including any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force,
- "Articles" means these Articles of Association of ICON EAST MIDLANDS,
- "Associate" means a person admitted as an Associate in accordance with these Articles.
- "Clear Days" means in relation to the period of a notice means the period excluding the day when the notice is given or deemed to be given and the day for which it is given or on which it is to take effect,

"Director" means a director of ICON EAST MIDLANDS,

"Executed" includes any mode of execution,

"Local Authority Associate" means any person associated with a local authority for the purposes of Section 69 of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 and any regulations and orders made thereunder,

"Member" means a member of ICON EAST MIDLANDS admitted to membership in accordance with these Articles,

"Memorandum" means the Memorandum of Association of ICON EAST MIDLANDS,

"Objects" means the objects from time to time of ICON EAST MIDLANDS in accordance with Clause 3 of the Memorandum,

"Office" means the registered office of ICON EAST MIDLANDS,

"Public Body" means a person that is a public body under the Local Authorities (Goods and Services) Act 1970,

"Seal" means the common seal of ICON EAST MIDLANDS if it has one,

"Secretary" means the secretary of ICON EAST MIDLANDS or any other person appointed to perform the duties of the secretary of ICON EAST MIDLANDS, including joint assistant or deputy secretary,

"Subscriber" means the subscriber to the Memorandum,

"United Kingdom" means Great Britain and Northern Ireland

Members and Associates

- The Subscriber and such other persons or organisations as are admitted to membership in accordance with the rules made under Article 51 shall be Members of ICON EAST MIDLANDS. No person shall be admitted a Member of ICON EAST MIDLANDS unless their application for membership is approved by all the Members and save that for the first six months after the incorporation of ICON EAST MIDLANDS a person or organisation shall be admitted if the Subscriber shall so require at a time when the subscriber is a Member
- 2 2 Unless the Members in general meeting shall make other provision under Article 51, the Directors may in their absolute discretion permit any Member of ICON EAST MIDLANDS to retire, provided that after such retirement the number of Members is not less than one
- 2.3 No person or organisation shall be admitted to be or continue to be a Member at any time when a Member appointed pursuant to a requisition by the Subscriber objects to that person or organisation being admitted as or remaining as a Member

Notice of General Meeting

- All general meetings shall be called by at least 14 clear days notice but a general meeting may be called by shorter notice if it is so agreed

in the case of any other meeting by a majority in number of Members having a right to attend and vote, being a majority together holding not less than 90 per cent of the total voting rights at the meeting of all the Members

The notice shall specify the time and place of the meeting and the general nature of the business to be transacted and, in the case of an annual general meeting, shall specify the meeting as such

The notice shall be given to all the Members and to the Directors and auditors

The accidental omission to give notice of a meeting to or the non receipt of notice of a meeting, by any person entitled to receive notice shall not invalidate the proceedings at that meeting

Proceedings at General Meetings

- No business shall be transacted at any meeting unless a quorum is present each being a Member or a duly authorised representative of a Member. A half of the persons entitled to attend and vote upon the business to be transacted shall constitute a quorum (provided that where such number is not a whole number, then the number shall be rounded down to the next whole number)
- If a quorum is not present within half an hour from the time appointed for the meeting, or if during a meeting a quorum ceases to be present, the meeting shall stand adjourned to the same day in the next week at the same time and place or to such time and place as the Directors may determine
- A Member or the duly appointed representative of a Member chosen by the Members or their representatives to be the chair of the meeting shall preside as chair of the meeting, but if that chair is not present within 15 minutes after the time appointed for holding the meeting, the Members present shall elect one of their number to be chair

authorised shall be entitled to exercise the same powers (including for the avoidance of doubt, voting on a show of hands) on behalf of the person or organisation which that individual represents that such organisation could exercise if it were an individual member of ICON EAST MIDLANDS

Advisory Groups

Appointment, Retirement and Expenses of Associates and Advisory Groups

- 19 1 Subject to these Articles the Directors may appoint from time to time such persons as they deem appropriate to be members of an Advisory Group
- 19 2 The Members may appoint persons who are willing to act to an Advisory Group
- 19 3 A natural person, other person or organisation that is or is the duly appointed representative of a member of an Advisory Group shall not be a Director of ICON EAST MIDLANDS, may be paid reasonable expenses in a like manner to a Director and if that person is an employee or secondee may receive reasonable and proper remuneration for services rendered pursuant to the Memorandum
- 19.4 The Associates shall be an Advisory Group and each Associate shall be represented on that Advisory Group by a natural person duly notified to ICON EAST MIDLANDS

Proceedings of Advisory Groups

20

- 20 1 The members of an Advisory Group may regulate their proceedings as they think fit, save that the Advisory Group shall not have or exercise any management, directory or fiduciary responsibility in relation to ICON EAST MIDLANDS
- 20.2 The Advisory Group comprising the Associates shall act as a principal and authoritative forum for facilitating ICON EAST MIDLANDS's work in relation

to the understanding of the various business, practical, presentational, professional, technical, educational, ethical, aesthetic, regulatory and environmental issues arising out of furtherence or fulfilment of the Objects

Directors

- 21 The number of Directors shall be not less than one but (unless otherwise determined by ordinary resolution) shall not be subject to any maximum
- The first Directors shall be those persons named in the statement delivered pursuant to section 10(2) of the Act, who shall be deemed to have been appointed under the Articles

 Future Directors shall be appointed as provided subsequently in these Articles

Powers of Directors

- Subject to the provisions of the Act, the Memorandum and the Articles and to any directions given by special resolution, the business of ICON EAST MIDLANDS shall be managed by the Directors who may exercise all the powers of ICON EAST MIDLANDS. No alteration of the Memorandum or the Articles and no such direction shall invalidate any prior act of the Directors which would have been valid if that alteration had not been made or that direction had not been given. The powers given by this Article shall not be limited by any special power given to the Directors by the Articles and a meeting of the Directors at which a quorum is present may exercise all the powers exercisable by the Directors
- In addition to all powers hereby expressly conferred by them and without detracting from the generality of their powers under the Articles the Directors shall have the following powers, namely
 - 24.1 to expend the funds of ICON EAST MIDLANDS in such manner as they shall consider most beneficial for the furtherance or achievement of the Objects and to invest in the name of ICON EAST MIDLANDS such part of the funds as they may see fit and to direct the sale or transposition of any such investments and to expend the proceeds of any such sale in furtherance of the Objects of ICON EAST MIDLANDS and to take and act on such advice as may seem to them appropriate in all the circumstances from time to time,

- 24.2 to enter into agreements with providers of funds and other resources to ICON EAST MIDLANDS concerning how ICON EAST MIDLANDS's funds and other assets or any part of them shall be accounted for and utilised.
- 24 3 to enter into contracts or grant funding agreements on behalf of ICON EAST MIDLANDS

Appointment and Retirement of Directors

- No individual may be appointed as or remain as a Director unless
 - 25.1 that individual has attained the age of 18 years, and
 - 25 2 any proposed Director would not as a Director have been disqualified under the provisions of Article 28,
 - 25 3 the proposed Director is nominated by a Member of ICON EAST MIDLANDS and at such time there is no other serving Director appointed by such Member
- Subject to Article 25, ICON EAST MIDLANDS may by ordinary resolution appoint an individual who is willing to act to be a Director to fill a vacancy
- 27 The Directors shall not be liable to retire by rotation

Disqualification and Removal of Directors

- A Director shall be a natural person and shall cease to hold office and a proposed Director shall not be appointed if that person
 - 28.1 ceases to be Director by virtue of any provision in the Act, is otherwise prohibited by law from being a Director or is disqualified from acting as a charity trustee by virtue of section 72 of the Charities Act 1993 (or any statutory re-enactment or modification of that provision), or,
 - 28.2 becomes bankrupt or insolvent or makes any arrangement or composition with his creditors generally,
 - 28.3 becomes incapable by reason of mental disorder, illness or injury or legal impediment of managing and administering that person's own affairs,

- 28 4 resigns the office of director by notice to ICON EAST MIDLANDS (but only if at least one Director will remain in office when the notice of registration is to take effect),
- 28.5 is absent without the permission of the Directors from all their meetings held within a period of six months and the Directors resolve that that person's office be vacated,
- 28 6 is or becomes a Local Authority Associate if on appointment as or on continuation of their Directorship they and all the other Directors that are or would be Local Authority Associates are 20% or more of the Directors and such that a more recently admitted such Director shall cease to be a Director before a Director appointed less recently unless the Directors shall determine otherwise.

Directors Remuneration and Expenses

The Directors shall not be paid any remuneration, expenses or other payments or given any benefits or perquisites by ICON EAST MIDLANDS save as permitted by the Memorandum and shall otherwise account to ICON EAST MIDLANDS for any money or other benefits that they receive from any person in respect of or in connection with ICON EAST MIDLANDS's business save to the extent that such moneys and benefits are received from their principal employments, partnerships, offices or businesses

Directors' Appointments

30 Subject to the provisions of the Act and the Memorandum, the Directors may appoint one or more of their number to the office of chair of the Directors, chief executive or to any other executive office under ICON EAST MIDLANDS. Any such appointment

may be made upon such terms as the Directors determine subject to the provisions of the Memorandum. Any appointment of a Director to an executive office or as their chair shall terminate if and when that Director ceases to be a Director.

31 Except to the extent permitted by the Memorandum, no Director shall take or hold any interest in property belonging to ICON EAST MIDLANDS or receive remuneration or be interested otherwise than as a Director in any other contract to which ICON EAST MIDLANDS is a party

Proceedings of Directors

- Subject to the provisions of the Articles, the Directors may regulate their proceedings as they think fit. A Director may, and the Secretary at the request of a Director shall, call a meeting of the Directors. It shall not be necessary to give notice of a meeting to a Director who is absent from the United Kingdom. Questions arising at a meeting shall be decided by a majority of votes.
 - 32.1 The quorum for the transaction of the business of the Directors shall be a half of their number (provided that where such number is not a whole number, then the number shall be rounded down to the next whole number) present or deemed present
 - 32.2 Each Director shall have one vote and the chair shall not have a casting vote
 - 32.3 For the purposes of these Articles, a Director shall be deemed to be present at any meeting of the Directors if that Director is able to hear and understand all of the proceedings of the meeting and be able to be heard and understood by all those present by way of a telephone or other suitable means of communication and such Director indicates their willingness to proceed on that basis. A meeting where those present or deemed to be present are in different locations shall unless the Directors determine otherwise be deemed to be place where the largest group of those participating is assembled, or, if there is no such group, where the chair of the meeting then is
- The Directors may act notwithstanding any vacancies in their number, but, if the number of Directors is less than three then the continuing Directors or Director may act only for the purpose of filling vacancies or a calling a general meeting

The Directors may appoint one of their number to be the chair of their meeting and may at any time remove that Director from that office. Unless the chair is unwilling to do so, the Director so appointed shall preside at every meeting of Directors at which the chair is present but if there is no Director holding that office, or if the Director holding it is unwilling to preside or is not present within five minutes after the time appointed for the meeting, the Directors may appoint one of their number to be chair of the meeting.

- 35.1 The Directors may appoint one or more sub-committees consisting of two or more Directors for the purposes of making any inquiry or supervising or performing any function or duty which in the opinion of the Directors would be more conveniently undertaken or carried out by a sub-committee, provided that all acts and proceedings of each such sub-committee shall be fully and promptly reported to the Directors
- 35.2 The Directors may also appoint persons or committees (comprised of Directors or other persons as the Directors see fit) to fulfil advisory, administrative or management roles
- 35.3 No person shall be appointed to a committee or committees or subcommittees shall be appointed other than pursuant to Articles 35.1 or 35.2

Resolutions

- All acts done by a meeting of Directors, or of a committee of Directors or Members shall, notwithstanding that it be afterwards discovered that there was a defect in the appointment of any Directors or Members or that any of them were disqualified from being a Member, from holding office, or had vacated office, or were not entitled to vote, be as valid as if every such person had been duly appointed and was qualified and had continued to be a Director or Member and had been entitled to vote
- A resolution in writing, signed digitally or by hand by a majority of the Directors entitled to receive notice of a meeting of Directors or of a committee of Directors, and a resolution in writing, signed digitally or by hand by that proportion of all the Members specified by the Act as necessary to give effect to the resolution having regard to the nature and content of the resolution, shall be as valid and effective as if

It had been passed at a meeting of Members or (as the case may be) a committee of Directors or Members duly convened and held. Such a resolution may consist of several documents in the same form, each signed by one or more of the Directors or by or on behalf of one or more of the Members.

Bank Accounts

Any bank account in which any part of the assets of ICON EAST MIDLANDS is deposited shall be operated in accordance with the instructions of the Directors and shall indicate the name of ICON EAST MIDLANDS and its charitable status. All cheques and orders for payment of money shall be signed by at least two Directors or by two persons authorised as signatories by the Directors subject to such limitations and terms as they shall direct

Patrons

39 The Councils may nominate and the Directors may appoint nominated patrons (by whatever title or description referred to) who shall hold office on such terms and undertake such functions as the Members shall from time to time determine

Secretary

Subject to the provisions of the Act, any Secretary shall be appointed by the Directors for such term, at such remuneration (if not a Director) and upon such conditions as they may think fit, and any secretary so appointed may be removed by them. The Secretary shall be entitled to attend all the meetings of the Members of the Directors and of the Advisory Group

Minutes

- The Directors shall keep minutes in books kept for the purpose
 - 41.1 of all appointments of officers made by the Directors,
 - of all proceedings at meetings of ICON EAST MIDLANDS and of the Directors and of committees of Directors including the names of the Directors present at each such meeting

The Seal

The seal, if there is one, shall only be used by the authority of the Directors or of a committee of Directors authorised by the Directors. The Directors may determine who shall sign any instrument to which the seal is affixed and unless otherwise so determined it shall be signed by a Director and by the Secretary or by a second Director.

Accounts

Accounts shall be prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Act and relevant statute and regulation and recommended and relevant practice guides as may apply from time to time

Charitable Trusts

The Directors shall comply with their obligations under the Charities Act 1993, the Charities Act 2006, the Law of Property Act 1925, the Settled Land Act 1925, the Trustee Acts 1925 and 2000 and other relevant legislation and law in respect of the administration of any charitable trusts for which ICON EAST MIDLANDS may have fiduciary or other responsibilities

Annual Return

The Directors shall comply with their obligations under the Act (or any statutory reenactment or modification of the Act) with regard to the preparation of an annual return and its transmission to Company's House

Notice

- Any notice to be given to or by any person pursuant to the Articles shall be in writing including by digital means
- ICON EAST MIDLANDS may give any notice to a Member or Director either personally or by sending it by post in a prepaid envelope addressed to the Member or Director at the address that they have notified ICON EAST MIDLANDS of in writing or their registered address or by leaving it at either address or by email, receipt of which is acknowledged. A Member or Director whose address or registered address is not within the United Kingdom and who gives to ICON EAST.

MIDLANDS an address within the United Kingdom at which notices may be given to that Member or Director shall be entitled to have notices given to that Member or Director at that address, but otherwise no such Member or Director shall be entitled to receive any notice from ICON EAST MIDLANDS

Indemnity

- 50 1 Subject to the provisions of the Act every Director or other officer or auditor of ICON EAST MIDLANDS shall be indemnified out of the assets of ICON EAST MIDLANDS against any liability incurred by them in that capacity in defending any proceedings, whether civil or criminal, in which judgment is given in their favour or in which they are acquitted or in connection with any application in which relief is granted to them by the Court from liability for negligence, default, breach of duty or breach of trust in relation to the affairs of ICON EAST MIDLANDS
- The Directors shall have power to resolve pursuant to the Memorandum to effect indemnity insurance notwithstanding their interest in any such policy

Rules

51.1 The Directors may from time to time make such rules or bye laws as they may deem necessary or expedient or convenient for the proper conduct and management of ICON EAST MIDLANDS and for the purpose of prescribing

classes of and conditions of Members and Associates, and in particular but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, they may by such rules or bye laws regulate

- 51 1 1 the admission and classification of Members (including the admission of organisations to membership) and the rights and privileges of such Members including whether they shall be entitled to attend or vote at meetings of ICON EAST MIDLANDS and the conditions of membership and the terms on which Members may resign or have their membership terminated and the entrance fees, subscription and other fees or payments to be made by Members,
- 51 1 2 the admission of Associates and the rights and privileges of such Associates,
- 51 1 3 the conduct of Members and Associates in relation to one another, and to ICON EAST MIDLANDS's servants,
- 51 1 4 the setting aside of the whole or any part or parts of ICON EAST MIDLANDS's premises at any particular time or times or for any particular purpose or purposes,
