## Principal activities, review of the business and future developments

The principal activity of the company is that of providing banking and purchasing services for fellow group undertakings which carry out land and property investment in the United Kingdom

During the year under review the group continued its property investment activities and in particular continued the process of seeking to secure suitable planning permission for its strategic land sites
