1. Accounting Policies

1.1. Basis of Preparation of Financial Statements

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

1.2. Going Concern Disclosure

The accounts have been prepared on a going concern basis as at 30th November 2017 the liablities exceeded the assets by £28017 (£16587 - 2016). The company meets it's day to day working capital requirements through a loan provided by the shareholders who are also directors. In light of this ongoing support the directors believe that it is apprpriate to prepare the accounts on a going concern which assumes that the company will continue in operational existence for the forseeable future.

1.3. Turnover

Turnover comprises the invoiced value of goods and services supplied by the company, net of Value Added Tax and trade discounts. All income is derived from activities within the UK.

1.4. Tangible Fixed Assets and Depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost of the fixed assets, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives on the following bases:

Freehold 2% straight line

Fixtures & Fittings 15% reducing balance

1.5. Stocks and Work in Progress

Stocks and work in progress are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value after making due allowance for obsolete and slow-moving stocks. Cost includes all direct costs and an appropriate proportion of fixed and variable overheads. Work-in-progress is reflected in the accounts on a contract by contract basis by recording turnover and related costs as contract activity progresses.

The directors reviewed stock at the year end and revalued to take into account obsolete and damaged stock. This revaluation resulted in the gross loss shown for the year.
