Closer to home, GlobalEd's influence continues to strengthen the work of UK schools and educational institutions bringing the region of Latin America into the learning environments of an increasing number of participants. Established programmes of teaching and learning are continuing to pioneer the work in school partnerships in developing ESD with Peru which is having a significant impact for educational development in the region.

Uncertainty in external political decisions in the UK regarding ESD and global partnerships between UK and Peruvian (Latin American) schools and how to repond has become an aspect of GlobalEd's work in ensuring that our methodolgy not only remains appropriate but continues to become sustainable itself

An incresae in the number of school visits reflects the emerging interest in latin America as a region for study. Specific income was generated with Deven Development Association in GlobalEd's part of Peruvian production for their recently published 'HolaPeru' resource for UK teachers.

Continued support from Plug into the Sun has been enjoyed in 2012 but this is looking precanous with uncertainty in the UK renewables market
