Notes to the Financial Statements for the year ended 31 March 2019

1. STATUTORY INFORMATION

J M Posner Limited is a private company, limited by shares, registered in England and Wales. The company's registered number and registered office address can be found on the Company Information page.

The presentation currency of the financial statements is the Pound Sterling (£).

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" including the provisions of Section 1A "Small Entities" and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Turnover

Turnover is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable, excluding discounts, rebates, value added tax and other sales taxes.

Intangible assets

Intangible assets are initially measured at cost. After initial recognition, intangible assets are measured at cost less any accumulated amortisation and any accumulated impairment losses.

Patents are being amortised evenly over their estimated useful life of ten years.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Short leasehold - Straight line over the life of the lease

Plant and machinery - 25% reducing balance
Fixtures and fittings - 15% reducing balance
Computer equipment & website costs - Straight line over 25 years

Stocks

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items.

Taxation

Taxation for the year comprises current and deferred tax. Tax is recognised in the Income Statement, except to the extent that it relates to items recognised in other comprehensive income or directly in equity.

Current or deferred taxation assets and liabilities are not discounted.

Current tax is recognised at the amount of tax payable using the tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the statement of financial position date.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the statement of financial position date.

Timing differences arise from the inclusion of income and expenses in tax assessments in periods different from those in which they are recognised in financial statements. Deferred tax is measured using tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the year end and that are expected to apply to the reversal of the timing difference.

Unrelieved tax losses and other deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that it is probable that they will be recovered against the reversal of deferred tax liabilities or other future taxable profits.

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES - continued

Research and development

Expenditure on research and development is written off in the year in which it is incurred.

Foreign currencies

Assets and liabilities in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rates of exchange ruling at the statement of financial position date. Transactions in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rate of exchange ruling at the date of transaction. Exchange differences are taken into account in arriving at the operating result.

Hire purchase and leasing commitments

Rentals paid under operating leases are charged to profit or loss on a straight line basis over the period of the lease.

Pension costs and other post-retirement benefits

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme. Contributions payable to the company's pension scheme are charged to profit or loss in the period to which they relate.

Financial instruments

Financial instruments are classified and accounted for, according to the substance of the contractual arrangement, as either financial assets, financial liabilities or equity instruments. An equity instrument is any contract that evidences a residual interest in the assets of the company after deducting all of its liabilities.

9. DIRECTORS' ADVANCES, CREDITS AND GUARANTEES

The directors, have given a personal guarantee to National Westminster Bank Plc for an overdraft facility of £60,000.

The bank loan is secured by a personal guarantee given to National Westminster Bank Plc, by the directors.

10. RELATED PARTY DISCLOSURES

During the year, total dividends of £158,000 were paid to the directors .

As at the year end date, J M Posner General Trading LLC, a company incorporated in Dubai in which Mr J M Posner is a director and a shareholder, owed the company £399,042 (2018: £348,514) which is included in trade debtors and £139,999 (2018: £139,399) which is included in other debtors.

As at the year end date, J M Posner Trading Ltd, a company incorporated in England and Wales in which Mr J M Posner is a director and a shareholder, owed the company £143,668 (2018: £143,668) which is included in other debtors.

As at the year end date, the directors, Mr J M Posner and Mrs T J Posner , had a credit balance on their joint directors' current account of £88 (2018: £156,438 debit) and is included in other creditors
