1 Accounting policies

The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008). We believe that the company's financial statements should be prepared on a going concern basis on the grounds that current and future sources of funding or support will be more than adequate for the company's needs. We believe that no further disclosures relating to the company's ability to continue as a going concern need to be made in the financial statements. In assessing going concern, we have paid particular attention to a period of not less than one year from the date of approval of the financial statements.

Turnover
