We are a community rugby club providing first class facilities for coaching, playing, volunteering, supporting and all social aspects of rugby. The club is open to all members of the community and we strive to give parents and children the opportunity to overcome any barriers that may otherwise prevent involvement in sport. We provide volunteer and community coaches to local schools, running lessons and after school clubs. We give children a chance to practice sporting skills, learn how to work as a team and take part in physical activity, encouraging participation and creating a pathway for young people to get involved in community clubs and sport and at the same time promote a healthy lifestyle. We lease a clubhouse from the local authority located in a public park in Long Eaton which is available to all community groups to use for social events, meetings and gatherings.

During 2016/2017 we met with our stakeholders via a series of informal meetings to find out what more the club could do for the community resulting in agreement that we would continue to support local schools and provide community rugby coaching and help engage children in physical activities at a young age. We also agreed that extending the clubhouse would provide a more usable space for local community groups to meet and socialise and longer term projects would include extending the facilities further to provide a fitness suite and gym.

We have continued to support local schools as planned and have provided rugby training sessions to hundreds of children as a result. In 2017 the clubhouse was extended, utilising an area of the building that was previously in disrepair. We now have a facility that is used by many community groups and local sports clubs throughout the year. We have been able to hold community events like a Christmas Fair and Fundraising events for local charities that were not possible before the extension.
