We are a community rugby club providing first class facilities for coaching, playing, volunteering, supporting and all social aspects of rugby. The club is open to all members of the community and we strive to give parents and children the opportunity to overcome any barriers that may otherwise prevent involvement in sport. We provide volunteer and community coaches to local schools, running lessons and after school clubs. We give children a chance to practice sporting skills, learn how to work as a team and take part in physical activity, encouraging participation and creating a pathway for young people to get involved in community clubs and sport and at the same time promote a healthy lifestyle. We lease a clubhouse from the local authority located in a public park in Long Eaton which is available to all community groups to use for social events, meetings and gatherings.

During 2019/2020 we met with our stakeholders via a series of formal and informal meetings to find out what more the club could do for the community. We have continued to increase our social media presence to improve engagement with the local community and members from further away. We have continued with our plan for improving our pitches, making them playable all year round. We have also continued to support local schools via community rugby coaching and help engage children in physical activities at a young age. Plans to employ a community rugby coach are in the early stages and will hopefully be in place during the 2020/2021 season.

Feedback also suggested a need for an artificial grass pitch on our current site and extension to the social areas to make them a more usable space for more community groups. We have continued the process of engaging the local authority and suppliers of 3G pitches although this will be a long term project forming a part of our 5 year plan.
