Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with applicable United Kingdom accounting standards.

Going concern

McCarthy & Stone Scottish Properties No.1 Limited was formed to invest in property. McCarthy & Stone Scottish Properties No.1 Limited's finance is provided through inter-company balances. The Group is headed by McCarthy & Stone Limited which is funded by loan facilities. The Group has confirmed that it will not seek repayment of inter-company balances within 12 months of signing the statutory financial statements of McCarthy & Stone Scottish Properties No.1 Limited. The Directors are in receipt of a letter of support from McCarthy & Stone Limited. The Directors are satisfied that the facilities and operations of the Group are sufficient to provide the assurances held within this letter. On this basis, the financial statements have been prepared on the going concern basis.

Profit and Loss Account

No profit and loss is presented with these financial statements because the Company has not received income, incurred expenditure or recognised any gains or losses during either the year under review or the preceding financial year.

Cash Flow Statement

No Cash Flow Statement has been prepared for the Company as it is itself a wholly owned UK incorporated subsidiary. A Group consolidated Cash Flow Statement is included in the financial statements of the ultimate parent undertaking, McCarthy & Stone Limited.
