Appendix D

RSM Restructuring Advisory LLP Charging, expenses and disbursements policy

Expenses and disbursements policy

- Any payments to outside parties in which the office holder or his firm or any associate has an interest will only be made with the approval of the relevant approving party.
- Expenses and disbursements re-charged to or incurred directly by an insolvency estate are subject to VAT at the applicable rate, where appropriate.
