The Directors are responsible for preparing the financial statements in accordance with applicable law and regulations.



- prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the company will continue in business.

The Directors are responsible for keeping adequate accounting records that are sufficient to show and explain the Company's transactions, disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the Company, and enable them to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Companies Act 2006. 
For the year ended 31 December 2016, the company was entitled to exemption from audit under section 480 of the Companies Act 2006 relating to dormant companies.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2016

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of accounting

Tesco Atrato Depot Propco Limited is a private company, limited by shares and incorporated in England and Wales.

The registered office is:

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with Section 1A of Financial Reporting Standard 102, the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland, and the Companies Act 2006.

As a dormant company within the Companies Act definition, the company has elected to retain its accounting policies for reported assets, liabilities and equity at the date of transition to this FRS until the company undertakes any new transactions.

Current taxation

The amount included in the Profit and Loss Account is based on the profit or loss on ordinary activities before taxation and is calculated at current local tax rates, taking into account timing differences and the likelihood of realisation of deferred tax assets and liabilities.

On 23 September 2009, the Company entered into a loan agreement with Tesco Property Finance 2 PLC. The loan is interest free, and is repayable within one month of 13 October 2039. No early repayment is permitted.

4. ULTIMATE PARENT UNDERTAKING AND CONTROLLING PARTY

The Company's immediate parent undertaking is Tesco Atrato (GP) Limited.

The Company's ultimate parent undertakings are Tesco PLC and Universities Superannuation Scheme Limited. Tesco PLC is registered in England and Wales and copies of the Tesco PLC financial statements can be obtained from the Company Secretary with registered address at Tesco PLC, Tesco House, Shire Park, Welwyn Garden City, AL7 1GA. The Universities Superannuation Scheme Limited financial statements can be obtained from 2nd Floor, Royal Liver Building, Liverpool, L3 1PY.

5. FIRST TIME ADOPTION OF FRS102

The policies applied under the entity's previous accounting framework are not materially different to FRS 102 and have not impacted on equity or profit or loss.
