NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2013

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparation of financial statements

The financial statements are prepared on the going concern basis, in accordance with applicable United Kingdom Accounting Standards, under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Companies Act 2006. The Company's principal accounting policies have been applied consistently during the year except for the amendment set out below.

Cash flow statement

The Company is a wholly owned subsidiary of Tesco Atrato (GP) Limited and is included in the consolidated financial statements of Tesco Atrato (GP) Limited which are publicly available. Consequently the Company has taken advantage of the exemption from preparing a cash flow statement under the terms of FRS 1 (Revised 1996) "Cash Flow Statements".

Current taxation

The amount included in the Profit and Loss Account is based on the profit or loss on ordinary activities before taxation and is calculated at current local tax rates, taking into account timing differences and the likelihood of realisation of deferred tax assets and liabilities.

Group relief on taxation

The Company may receive or surrender group relief from group companies without payment and consequently there may be no tax charge in the Profit and Loss Account.

2. PROFIT ON ORDINARY ACTIVITIES BEFORE TAXATION

The Directors received no emoluments for their services to the Company (2012: £nil).

The Company had no employees during the year (2012: none).

3. TAX ON PROFIT/(LOSS) ON ORDINARY ACTIVITIES

The Company is tax resident in the United Kingdom. However, there is no tax charge for the current year or prior year as the Company had no taxable income.

During the period, the UK main corporation tax rate changed from 23% to 21%. This was substantively enacted on 2 July 2013 and effective from 1 April 2012.

Further reductions to the UK corporation tax rate were announced in March 2013 Budget. The changes, which are expected to be enacted separately each year, propose to reduce the rate by 1% per annum to 20% by 1 April 2015. The changes had not been substantively enacted at the balance sheet date and therefore are not recognised in these financial statements.
