Reports of the Trustees

The organisation was set up as a result of the tragic and mindless killings of individual people by terrorist in Mumbai on 26th November 2008. This horrible scene was also witnessed by the charity's chair Deepak Kuntawala who was holed up in the Taj Hotel in Mumbai and was lucky to escape with his life with other guests.

The terrorism affected number of people and in its aftermath the most affected were the children who were orphaned DVK Foundation was thus set up by Deepak Kuntawala to support the well-being and the future of these children

With a great deal of enthusiasm and support from the Trustees and individuals. The Foundation staged an event at The Orangery, Kensington Palace and London to commemorate and remember those victims who perished and suffered injury in the attacks. The Chair of the Foundation, Deepak Kuntawala funded this event. However during the course of and run up to the event. The Foundation acquired debtors for which a contingent fund has been set aside. It is anticipated that over the course of the following year matters in respect of the debtors would have been resolved.

Since the event the work of the Foundation has been quite challenging and being in a fledgling state it faced unexpected publicity, which it was not well equipped to deal with since lots of its work was handled by individuals on a good will basis - Basically it did not have the apparatus and the machinery to deal with complex matters which an organisation of this stature would have required

In the last few months, experiencing these challenges The Foundation has seen these challenges as an opportunity to the deal with all matters important to the successful delivery and management of the work of the organisation. It has therefore started a process of re-appraising its position. This is given further impetus, in light of the fact that it lost its charity registration with the Charities Commission in November 2011.

This has meant a complete review of its aims and objectives and its strategic direction over the next five years as well as the registration of the Foundation as a charity with the Charities Commission. Work is now underway to identify individuals to act as officers of the Foundation as well as new Trustees to serve on its board. The work is quite complex and diverse, however we feel that with this approach and a clear strategic direction, the Foundation will prosper unhindered in its work to support children who have been orphaned across the world as a result of political and terrorist strife as well as meeting its key Charitable objectives.
