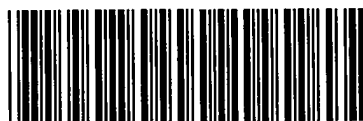

Statement of Directors' responsibilities

The Directors are responsible for keeping adequate accounting records that are sufficient to show and explain the Company's transactions and disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the Company, and enable them to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Companies Act 2006. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the Company and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

It is the Group's policy to maintain indemnity insurance for Directors and officers.

Notes to the accounts

1 Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with applicable accounting standards as defined in the Companies Act 2006 s.464.

2 Profit and loss account

No profit and loss account has been prepared as the Company has not traded during the year.

3 Cash flow statement

The Director has taken advantage of the exemption available under FRS 1 (Cash flow statements) of the requirement to prepare a cash flow statement as a consolidated cash flow statement has been presented in the financial statements of the ultimate parent undertaking, Acromas Holdings Limited.

4 Related party transactions

The Company has taken advantage of the exemption within FRS 8 (Related party disclosures) in not disclosing transactions with other entities in the Acromas group of companies.

5 Ultimate parent undertaking

The immediate parent undertaking is Titan Travel Holdings Limited, a company which is registered in England and Wales. The Company is wholly owned by Titan Travel Holdings Limited.

The financial statements of the Company have been consolidated in the group financial statements of Acromas Holidays Limited (an intermediate parent undertaking), Saga plc (an intermediate parent undertaking) and Acromas Holdings Limited (the ultimate parent undertaking), all of which are registered in England and Wales.

On 29 May 2014, Saga plc, an intermediate parent undertaking and the ultimate parent undertaking for the Saga group, was admitted to the London Stock Exchange.

Acromas Holidays Limited is the parent company of the smallest group of which the Company is a member and for which group financial statements are prepared.

6 Ultimate controlling party

The Director considers the ultimate controlling party to be funds advised by Charterhouse General Partners, CVC Capital Partners and Permira Advisers acting in concert.
