1 Accounting policies

Basis of preparation

The full financial statements, from which these abbreviated accounts have been extracted, have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (Effective April 2008).

Going concern

The company has net liabilities.

Included within creditors falling due after one year are loans from a connected company. In the opinion of the directors these loans will continue to be available for the foreseeable future and the company will be able to pay its other liabilities when they fall due.

Accordingly, the directors believe that the company will be able to continue as a going concern and the financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis.

Work in progress

Work in progress is valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

Deferred tax

Where material, deferred tax is recognised in respect of timing differences that have originated but not reversed by the balance sheet date. Deferred tax balances are not discounted.

Financial instruments

Financial instruments are classified and accounted for, according to the substance of the contractual arrangement, as financial assets, financial liabilities or equity instruments. An equity instrument is any contract that evidences a residual interest in the assets of the company after deducting all of its liabilities. Where shares are issued, any component that creates a financial liability of the company is presented as a liability in the balance sheet. The corresponding dividends relating to the liability component are charged as interest expense in the profit and loss account.
