

Encourage NW has been running for over 20 years primarily as a diverse arts, heritage and culture programme for people 50+ but with many projects and activities that have also had a cross-cultural and inter-generational focus. In the late 1990s the ENW project was run across a number of large cities in England, Scotland and N.Ireland but in the early 2010s the focus centred on NW England and the 2 major regions of Greater Manchester and Merseyside. This is where most of the collaborating partner organisations were based (museums, galleries, orchestras and theatres. For the last 2 years the programme has been on hold due to Covis and other lock-down restrictions and especially as many of our volunteers and participants were in the 70+ age bracket and more affected by Covid precautions and restrictions.

The project has had no funds and sought no new funds to continue the programme over the last 3 years and now there is a greater emphasis on reaching other age groups and more marginalised sections of community especially younger people with mental health difficulties and challenges and other age groups where loneliness and social isolation (aggravated and intensified) by the recent pandemic events. In 2020 the trustees and the existing user group decided to expand what has been a hugely successful ENW project to other smaller diverse groups who could benefit from a programme of art and culture based activities and projects as their older counterparts had done in previous 2 decades.

Two 'Open Days' were organised in the summer and autumn of 2021 in Cheshire and Merseyside to promote the newly expanded programme (though targeting reduced numbers of participation). Both sadly were cancelled due to Covid but have been re-scheduled for 2022. We have already had a good amount of interest especially from health care practitioners and primary health and social care providers who are looking for small-scale and very varied projects to assist with various groups of people with varied degrees of mental health and learning disability issues and conditions, especially low-med degrees of autism. We are also looking in 2022 at referrals from organisations and groups representing young teenage girls awaiting assessment from the respective counselling/mental health services- which are hugely difficult to access.

The ENW programme from 2021 onwards will have more horticultural, conservation and environmental projects and programmes as well as mentoring opportunities from our sound base of older volunteers, many of which are retired or former health and social care professionals and practitioners. There will also be a strong emphasis on relationship building and purely social, recreational and leisure activities to help with communication, life and personal skills and social inter-action across age groups and greater peer support. Our trustees and other volunteers and helpers will consider fund raising for such a diverse programme but the levels of participation and geographic coverage of the new initiative will be greatly reduced. When targeting older participants in previous years (mainly 60+) our numbers were 5000+ across all regions and many events were regularly over prescribed. We are not aiming to replicate the former ENW project but to reschedule and reshape it to fit the needs of present needs within the local community and to more targeted and more intensive health and social care needs and challenges (which are increasing) post Covid.

There has been far less face-to-face contact with stakeholders over the last 2 years prior to this we held regular feedback and programme planning events. In fact the ENW programme has largely been run, managed and co-ordinated by volunteer helpers and participants for its entirety since commencement. The 2 major open days planned in 2021 were both postponed due to Covid but we do have plans to press on with new initiatives in 2022. These will be fashioned and shaped by our volunteers and participation group of users.
