NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

YEAR ENDED 30th APRIL 2017

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(a) Basis of Accounting

The Financial Statements are prepared under the historic cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2007).

(b) Turnover

The turnover shown in the Income and Expenditure account represents amounts receivable during the year exclusive of Value Added Tax.

(c) Stocks

Stock is stated at the lower of cost or net realisable value.

(d) Fixed Assets

All fixed assets have been recorded at their original cost to the Barnet Elizabethans Rugby Football Club and were transferred to the Company at their net written down value after deduction of cumulative depreciation. Their original cost and depreciation to date have been disclosed in these accounts.

(e) Depreciation

Depreciation is calculated so as to write off the cost of an asset, less its estimated residual value, over the useful economic life of that asset as follows:

Long leasehold property - Over the lease term of 150 years

Clubhouse & ground improvements - On a straight-line basis at 10% per annum

Equipment and Fittings - On a straight-line basis relative to the estimated life

of the asset, varying between 10% and 33% per

annum.

(f) Grants Received

Grants were received during the year from the RFU Lead Up and Legacy Fund, the RFU Ground Match Scheme, the National Playing Fields Association, the London Borough of Barnet and the ECS Lottery fund relating to the purchase of floodlighting, clubhouse and pitch improvements and the car park. The related assets have been capitalised and depreciated in the accounts in accordance with note (e) above. The grants are being written off to income over a similar period of time as the related asset is being depreciated. See also note 12.
