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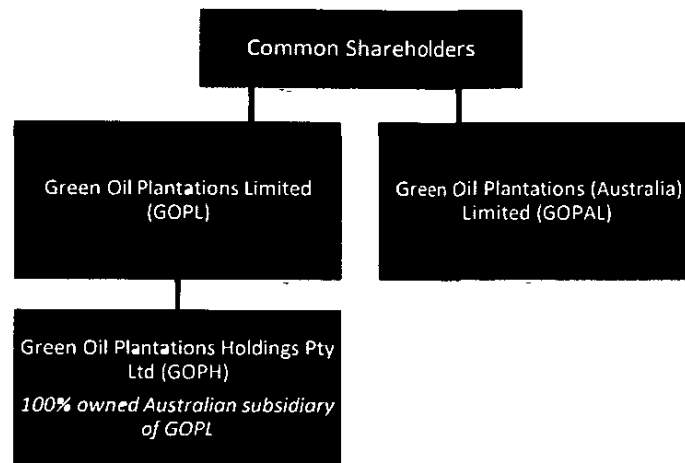
1 Introduction

- 1 1 Simon Kirkhope and Chad Griffin ("the Administrators") of FTI Consulting LLP ("FTI") were appointed as Joint Administrators of GOPL and GOPAL (collectively "the Companies") on 15 April 2013
- 1 2 The Administrators were appointed by the directors of the Companies out of court in accordance with Paragraph 22, Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986, as amended ("the Act")
- 1 3 The Financial Conduct Authority (the "FCA") consented to the appointment of Administrators on 15 April 2013
- 1 4 Simon Kirkhope and Chad Griffin are licensed by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of England and Wales, to act as Insolvency Practitioners. The Administrators act jointly and severally so that all functions may be exercised by each and either of them
- 1 5 This Report and Statement of Proposals ("the Report") is prepared pursuant to Paragraph 49, Schedule B1 to the Act in relation to the Companies, the purpose of which is to provide creditors with an update as to the present position of the Companies and Administrators' future strategy
- 1 6 This Report includes information required to be provided to creditors pursuant to Rule 2.33 of the Insolvency Rules 1986 (as amended) ("the Rules"). Statutory information pertaining to the Companies and as required by the Rules is set out in Appendix A
- 1 7 This Report also includes a Notice of Creditors Meeting (Form 2.20B), which meeting will be held in London on Friday 21 June 2013 at 11am (See Appendix J)

2 Background to the Companies and Events Leading up to the Administrations

- 2 1 Green Oil Plantations operates through two UK Companies, GOPL and GOPAL, and a fully owned Australian subsidiary, Green Oil Plantations Holdings Pty Ltd ("GOPH"). A group structure chart at the date of administration is included below

Organisation Chart



- 2 2 The Companies were established in 2010 as a UK based investment scheme. The Companies raised funds from primarily UK based investors to fund the establishment of an Australian *Millettia* plantation through GOPH. The aim was to provide an investment return through the sale of the trees' oil as biofuel together with ancillary products, including livestock feed and organic fertiliser. The investment scheme was unregulated.
- 2 3 Between March 2010 and January 2013, the UK Companies marketed and sold the products via a distribution network of agents and SIPP providers, with the different product types as set out in the table below.

- 2 4 The Companies raised £24 4m in funds from 1,131 private investors, 75 per cent of whom invested less than £30,000 and approximately 19 per cent were invested through self-invested pension schemes ("SIPPS") The investment sizes ranged from £8,000 to £272,000

- 2 5 The structure of the investment products varied, but had some common key characteristics including that for an initial investment (e g £10,000) investors would buy a number of trees (463 for each £10,000 invested) and receive a sub-lease of a plot of plantation land The products were structured to give an annual return or to pay a terminal return

Ownership and leasing arrangements

- 2 6 fGOPL was first granted a 20 year lease over the plantation land by GOPH as freehold owner under a number of master lease agreements
- 2 7 GOPL then entered into a series of sub-leasing and management arrangements with the Investors, commencing in 2010. These arrangements involved the following
- a) the Investor would be granted a sub-lease of a plot of land on the plantation by GOPL as landlord under a lease agreement with GOPH governed by Queensland law, and
 - b) the Investor would enter into the lease application and buyback management contract with GOPL governed by English law, pursuant to which each Investor and GOPL agreed that
 - the Investor would purchase a number of *Millettia* trees from GOPL in accordance with the terms of a lease application form,
 - GOPL would be granted the following by the Investor
 - a sub-tenancy of the plot under a separate tenancy agreement, or
 - rights in common to access their plot
 - GOPL would manage and cultivate the trees on behalf of the Investor,
 - GOPL committed to pay annual interest to the Investor at certain set amounts (but only for annual return products), and
 - GOPL would buy the trees back from the Investor at a set price at the end of the contractual term
- 2 8 The GOPAL structure was slightly different. Investors entered into a lease application and buyback agreement with GOPAL (as outlined above), but were granted the sub-lease of a plot by GOPL. The implications of this are discussed later in this report
- 2 9 A summary of the contractual framework for the Companies is set out in Appendix B
- 2 10 The products varied in relation to the investment term that was offered to investors. The majority of products sold offered contractual terms of 5 years (77 per cent by value), but 8-year, 10-year and 20-year products were also sold
- 2 11 As at the date of Administration, 53 leases had not been registered with the Queensland Land Registry and therefore such leases are currently incomplete
- 2 12 Funds raised after the deduction of commissions, fees and UK office expenses were loaned to the GOPH to purchase land and establish the plantation. As at the point of Administration, 8

out of the 9 plots of plantation land had been planted – these plots were planted over the period between Q3 2010 to Q2 2013, as set out in the following table

- 2 13 The plots that make up the plantation are located in the in Arriga and Dimbulah area, west of Mareeba, Queensland but not all are located next to one another
- 2 14 The plantation was managed by Burman Bio Energy Pty Ltd (Burman Bio Energy) under a Plantation Management Agreement Burman Bio Energy is run by Neville Burman Neville Burman is a shareholder of GOPL and GOPAL and was a director of both companies until he resigned on 6 April 2013 He was also a director of GOPH prior to the appointment of the Australian Receivers
- 2 15 To date no material income has been generated from the Millettia plantation, as the first trees planted have yet to reach first harvest There were minimal levels of income generated by GOPH in the form of rent of farm buildings, bank interest and asset sales No funds have been remitted back to the UK The only income generated in the UK was in respect of administration fees for registering leases
- 2 16 Invested funds have been spent on sales and marketing costs (circa 15 per cent of all investment sales), land purchase and plantation establishment and running costs, plantation management fees (15 per cent of all costs incurred in Australia) and paying interest to investors A table summarising the sources and application of funds is set out below

- 2.17 When GOPH was first established it did not have its own bank account, so payments were made directly from GOPL to other Burman group companies (including Palm Plantations of Australia Pty Ltd, Burman Future Pty Ltd and Burman Bioenergy Pty Ltd) presumably to meet costs and/or other expenses of GOPH. The Australian Receivers are seeking clarity on this position.
- 2.18 By the end of March 2013 the limited funds left in the Companies were insufficient to fund the plantation to the point of first harvest and to meet contractual investor returns. As a consequence, the directors concluded that the Companies were insolvent. The decision was made by the Companies' directors to place the Companies in to Administration on 5 April 2013.
- 2.19 Due to uncertainty regarding the regulatory status of the investment scheme, consent was sought from the Financial Conduct Authority (the "FCA") to ensure that, pending the outcome of the review by the FCA, the Administration appointments were valid.
- 2.20 FCA approval to the appointment of Administrators was received on 15 April 2013 and the Administration appointments were made on the same day. Receivers and Managers were appointed over GOPH on 19 April 2013 in order to obtain control over the underlying plantation asset.

Factors Contributing to the Administration

- 2 21 The majority of products were structured such that fixed returns were paid to investors from the first investment anniversary. However, the first harvest of green oil nuts was not initially forecast to be achieved for a period of 2 years (and in practice, may be significantly longer). Furthermore, only one plot was planted in 2010, following delays caused by, inter alia, bad weather (which delayed planting) and an FSA investigation in the UK which led to a delay in raising funds (and therefore making funds available to GOPH for the purchase of land). The remainder of the plots (with the exception of plot 13) were planted over an extended period and required the same maturity period. This resulted in the obligations to pay returns to investors outstripping income generation.
- 2 22 The business model relied on initial forecasts for the *Millettia* plantation that showed high oil yields after two years of tree growth. This was based on a plantation operating model that involved growing the trees at a high density (supported by ongoing irrigation and addition of fertiliser). We understand that this is an untested technique for this species and scale of plantation. The initial forecasts also relied on income from supplementary products, primarily animal feed and fertiliser. To date, these supplementary products have not generated revenue and there are material uncertainties as to whether these are capable of generating significant net revenue.
- 2 23 Additionally, there were high upfront establishment costs and ongoing fees. These included circa 15 per cent commission and fee payments on investments raised and a 15 per cent plantation management fee (which was levied on all costs incurred by GOPH, including land acquisition costs).

Regulatory Status

- 2 24 The investment scheme was unregulated. Its regulatory status was reviewed by the Financial Services Authority (the "FSA") in 2010, who were satisfied at that time that the scheme could continue to operate as an unregulated scheme provided it operated in line with the representations made to the FSA. However, the directors received legal advice (from a newly engaged firm) in March 2013 that the characteristics of the investment scheme (in terms of how it operated in practice) meant that, in their opinion, it should be authorised as a Collective Investment Scheme (a "CIS").
- 2 25 Following further representations and disclosure by the Administrators, the FCA concluded in May 2013 that the investment scheme should have been authorised by the FSA (since 1 April 2013, the FCA) as a CIS, and this has likely to have been the case since 2010.

- 2 26 Characteristics of the investment scheme used to support the FCA's conclusion that the scheme should have been regulated as a CIS include
- a The plantation was collectively and centrally managed on behalf of investors and there were material practical, legal and commercial barriers preventing the viability of any other management arrangement
 - b Investor funds were centrally pooled and fixed returns were paid out from the central fund pool rather than being linked to the performance of the plantation
- 2 27 The FCA's conclusion has an impact on the options available to the Administrators, as any proposed solution(s) will need to be compliant with the relevant regulations

3 Administration Objectives

- 3 1 The Administrators must perform their functions with the purpose of achieving one of the following statutory objectives
- rescuing the company as a going concern,
 - achieving a better result for the company's creditors as a whole than would be likely if the company were wound up, or
 - realising property in order to make a distribution to one or more secured or preferential creditors
- 3 2 The Administrators have considered the options available to them and concluded that the purpose of the administrations is to achieve a better result for the Companies' creditors as a whole than would be likely if the Companies were wound up without first being placed into administration. A rescue of the Companies as a going concern is not considered feasible given, inter alia, regulatory constraints. We discuss alternative restructuring options later in this report.
- 3 3 In the event that the Companies had been placed into liquidation without first being in administration, a liquidator would have been constrained in terms of spending funds in the estate as a means of preserving or improving value over the plantation asset, or in restructuring the project. It would also be more difficult to unencumber the plantation land inhibiting any sale to a third party.

4 Administrators' Strategy and Approach

4 1 The strategy for the GOPL Administration (and, where applicable, the GOPAL administration) is

- a To take control of the operations and assets of the UK Companies, and, by way of the appointment of a Receiver and Manager in Australia, to take control of GOPH, and to secure the books and records of the relevant Companies,
- b In conjunction with the Receiver, to take control of the day-to-day management of the plantation,
- c To engage independent, third party experts to assess the current status and future viability of the plantation (from both an agricultural and a commercial perspective),
- d In light of the outcome of c), to consider (in conjunction with legal advisers and the GOPH Receiver) the options available to the Companies to return value to creditors, being either by
 - a) a sale of the plantation as a whole to a third party (the "**Sale Option**"), or
 - b) establishing a new investment vehicle to hold the rights in the plantation and trees, which entity would issue shares or securities to the investors (and potentially also to other unsecured creditors) (the "**Restructuring Option**"), and
- e To implement the preferred solution in consultation with the Creditors' Committee (assuming one is formed) and the FCA, if appropriate. We envisage it being either the Restructuring Option or the Sales Option but we will discuss all potential options with the Creditors' Committee

5 Progress of the Administrations to Date

5 1 A summary of the key areas of work undertaken to date during the administrations is provided below. A full summary of receipts and payments in the administration estates of the Companies is provided at Appendix D

Initial Actions

5 2 Upon appointment on 15 April 2013, the Administrators took immediate control of the Companies and the Administrators' staff attended onsite at the Companies' Colchester office. Copies were taken of all IT infrastructure, hard copy documents were archived and the office was closed on 30 April 2013.

- 5 3 On the 19 April 2013, the Administrators (acting as agent of GOPL) appointed John Shanahan and Ginette Muller of FTI Consulting Brisbane as Receivers and Managers of GOPH (the "GOPH Receiver"), under the terms of the security which GOPL holds over the assets of GOPH

Legal Review

- 5 4 The Administrator have engaged Ashurst LLP to complete a legal review (in addition to advising on general legal matters) of the investment contracts and lease structure, together with an assessment of the legal mechanics to implement either the Sale Option or the Restructuring Option
- 5 5 The Administrators' legal advisers have concluded that executing either the Sale Option or Restructuring Option would likely require collapsing the lease and sub-lease structures to unencumber the title to the land. This could be achieved by using a company voluntary arrangement (a "CVA") under the Act, combined with action taken by the GOPH Receivers to forfeit the master leases. If this approach were approved by the requisite creditor majorities (75 per cent by value and 50 per cent by number), investors would be granted rights which may comprise
- a) a pro rata portion of any sale proceeds received from a third party purchaser (under the Sale Option), or
 - b) shares in a Newco (under the Restructuring Option)
- 5 6 It is therefore probable that a CVA will be proposed at a later date, and CVA proposals would be circulated to creditors at that time

Plantation Status

- 5 7 The Administrators are continuing to liaise closely with the GOPH Receiver. Burman Bioenergy is no longer managing the plantation and the GOPH Receiver is currently in discussions with an alternative contractor to provide short term maintenance to the plantations (including ongoing irrigation)
- 5 8 The Administrators have engaged Goldacove Pty Ltd ("Goldacove") and SGS United Kingdom Ltd to review various aspects of the plantations. The output of these reviews will assist the Administrators (in conjunction with the GOPH Receiver) in assessing the feasibility of the options under consideration

Goldacove Review

- 5 9 Goldacove is a bio-fuel research company which has experience of establishing and running a commercial Pongamia (Milletia) plantation. The team includes a botanical consultant and biochemist specialists.
- 5 10 The Goldacove report will estimate the potential yield for the plantation as well as their views on the feasibility of the forecast income streams and harvest dates. They will also suggest initiatives which may be implemented in the short term to provide funding, for example opportunities for the sale of non-essential assets.
- 5 11 At the time of this report, the Administrators have not yet received a final report from Goldacove. We will discuss the contents of the report with the Creditors' Committee (if appointed).

SGS Review

- 5 12 SGS are a global firm which specialises in testing, inspection, verification and certification services. The team engaged are largely agronomists experienced in completing agricultural audits.
- 5 13 The focus of the SGS report is to conduct a review of the health of the plantation (e.g. root quality, disease assessment), the growing conditions (e.g. local climate, soil fertility) and the density of planting. They will comment on the historical management of the plantation and will provide their own estimates of potential future production levels and harvest timing.
- 5 14 At the time of this report, the Administrators have not yet received the output from the SGS review. Their on-site work has been completed. We will discuss the contents of the report with the Creditors' Committee (if appointed).

Valuation

- 5 15 The GOPH Receivers have engaged Taylor Byrne (a firm of property consultants with experience in valuing agricultural/plantation land in the Tablelands region of Queensland, Australia) to provide a valuation of the plantation, which is required in order to assist the Administrators (in conjunction with the GOPH Receivers) in assessing the Sale Option.

Insurance

- 5 16 The Administrators (in conjunction with the GOPH Receivers) have reviewed the insurance cover in place for the Companies and GOPH. The insurance in place at the point of Administration covered assets only, e.g. tractors for natural hazard/loss events. At the date of

appointment of GOPH receivers only two plantation plots had specialist plantation insurance that would cover the value of the trees in the event of natural disasters namely fire, windstorm and hail. The GOPH Receivers has extended this insurance cover to all plots until October 2013 at a cost of circa AUD \$24,000.

Preliminary Investigations

- 5 17 The Administrators have taken to steps to secure the books and records (including the IT systems) of the Companies, and have conducted a review of relevant information in order to undertake a preliminary assessment (in conjunction with Ashurst LLP) of potential causes of action which may be available to either the Companies, the Administrators (or, if appropriate, a subsequently appointed liquidator) to recover value for the benefit of the Companies' creditors. These investigations are at an early stage, and any decision to proceed with recovery actions will follow consultation with the Creditors' Committee (assuming one is formed) and will be subject to the availability of funding.
- 5 18 We are also obliged to carry out certain investigative steps to comply with our reporting obligations on the conduct of directors (see below).

Cash at Bank

- 5 19 As at the date of the appointment of Administrators (15 April 2013), GOPL had £724k in its bank account. GOPAL does not operate a bank account at the present time. There were no funds remaining in the GOPH bank account at the date of appointment of the GOPH Receivers (19 April 2013). The GOPH Receivers have recovered approximately AUD \$96,000 in respect of deposits, prepayments and rent, which will be used to fund, valuation expenses, additional insurance (mentioned above) and short term plantation operating costs.

Other Realisations

- 5 20 There have been no realisations to date in the Administrations.

- 5 22 To date we have paid costs in respect of agricultural reviews of £28,872, which consists of £17,832 and £11,040 to SGS United Kingdom Ltd and Goldacove Pty Ltd respectively
- 5 23 Other payments made during the Administration include net wages of £4,014, office closure costs of £305 and stationary and postage at £628 GOPAL costs of £75 in respect of statutory advertising have been funded by GOPL
- 5 24 The nature of the Companies' financial services activities mean that the Companies were not registered for VAT and therefore cannot recover VAT on expenses
- 5 25 Accrued costs include FTI UK Administrator fees (see Appendix F) and legal fees of £76,812
- 5 26 The Administrators have utilised the services of other teams within FTI Consulting LLP to assist with the administration process The fees of our tax and technology team (who were used to copy and preserve the data taken from the UK office have been included in our overall SIP9 analysis of our time costs (See Appendix F)

- 5 27 We consider that the rates chargeable for these services are in line with general market practice and that the service is comparable to similar firms of professional advisors. In addition, by working closely with our internal teams, we believe a more coordinated and cost-effective approach to the administration work streams has been possible.
- 5 28 A full breakdown of payments made to date is included in the receipts and payments accounts for the period at Appendix D.

Employee Matters

- 5 29 In order to facilitate an orderly wind down of the UK operations, and in the preparation of financial information to assist the Administrators, two employees of GOPL were retained for two weeks. The other three UK employees, including the Companies' directors, were made redundant on the date of the appointment of the Administrators.
- 5 30 Redundant employees are required to complete an RP1 form in order to make a claim for their entitlement of arrears of wages, holiday pay, payment in lieu of notice and redundancy pay.
- 5 31 All employee claims are being dealt with by PayCo, whose contact details are as follows:

- 5 32 Once an employee has been paid by the Redundancy Payments Office (the "RPO"), the RPO takes over the employees' rights to recover that amount of the debt owed by the Companies.

Statutory Investigations

- 5 33 We have begun gathering data for our initial investigations work to comply with our statutory duties pursuant to the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986. We are obliged to review the conduct of all directors who served in respect of the Companies in the three year period prior to the date of Administrations.
- 5 34 Should any creditors have any further relevant information in relation to directors' conduct, they should provide details in writing to the Administrators. This request forms part of our normal investigations into directors' conduct and does not imply any criticism of the directors in this particular case.

- 5 35 The content of our reports in relation to this are confidential and must be submitted to the Department for Business, Innovation and Skills within six months of our appointment as Joint Administrators

Tax

- 5 36 We have undertaken corporation tax and VAT reviews. We will prepare the necessary tax returns to finalise the pre-appointment tax position, and will submit appropriate corporation tax, VAT and PAYE/NIC returns for the period of the Administrations. The Companies are not registered for VAT.

Unsecured creditors

- 5 37 As Administrators, we have a statutory duty to advertise for creditor claims. Any creditor who believes they may have a claim (including investors of record) should submit their claim to us as soon as possible.

Property

- 5 38 The Companies operated from leased offices in Colchester, and as at the date of Administration the rent on these offices had been paid until the end of April 2013, at which point we surrendered the lease, closed the office and incurred no further rental costs.

6 Statement of Affairs

- 6 1 Attached at Appendix E is a copy of the directors' estimated Statement of Affairs for the Companies as at the date of the appointment of the Administrators, 15 April 2013, together with a list of creditors at the time of appointment whose details have been provided by the directors (as extracted from the records of the Companies). Please note that the Statement of Affairs as prepared does not include any provision for the costs of the Administrations. Due to the current fundamental uncertainty surrounding the value of the plantation land, an estimate of the return to creditors (whether based on the information provided by the directors, or from our work to date) is not included in this section of the report.

- 6 2 The Statement of Affairs shows the following:

GOPL

- 6 3 According to the GOPL Statement of Affairs dated 29 April 2013, creditor claims total £25.9m. Approximately £22.1m relates to investor claims in respect of the initial investment amounts. Those investors represent around 85 per cent of all claims against GOPL.

6 4 £3.8m of creditor claims are made up of accrued interest to investors, together with approximately £1.2m of trail commissions, being commission due to Intelligent Partnerships (UK) Limited under a Master Distribution Agreement payable at 1% per annum for five years on products sold through their distribution network

6 5 Other creditor claims primarily relate to unpaid professional fees

GOPAL

6 6 The GOPAL statement of affairs dated 29 April 2013 shows a total of £2.96 million in creditor claims. Approximately £2.3 million relates to investor claims in respect of the initial investment amounts. Those investors represent around 78 per cent of all claims against GOPAL. A further £0.537m of creditor claims are made up of accrued interest owing to investors

6 7 GOPL has an intercompany claim against GOPAL of £145,000

7 Estimated Outcome

7 1 The principal asset of GOPAL (which in turn would generate any return to GOPAL creditors) is an unsecured claim against GOPH. This claim will rank behind the claim of GOPL, which benefits from a security interest over the assets of GOPH. As such, it is likely that creditors of GOPAL will receive a significantly lower return than the creditors of GOPL (and possibly a nil return), although the final outcome will be dependent upon whether the Sale Option or the Restructuring Option is pursued, and on further legal analysis of the contractual position

7 2 53 leases remained uncompleted at the point of Administration. It is unclear whether the lease structure will be collapsed in order to implement either the Sale Option or Restructuring Option. In any event, it is not possible at this stage to confirm whether this will affect the outcome for individual creditors (including those with uncompleted leases)

7 3 The position of the various classes of creditors for both of the Companies is set out below

GOPL

- **Secured creditors** – There are no secured creditors
- **Preferential creditors** – There are less than £10,000 in aggregate of employee claims. It is expected that all valid and agreed claims will be met in full
- **Prescribed part** – As there is no creditor holding a floating charge over the assets of the Company, no prescribed part will be required to be set aside

- **Unsecured creditors** – At this stage it is not possible to estimate within any degree of certainty the likely return to unsecured creditors. The GOPH Receiver has engaged a firm of property valuers, Taylor Byrne, to provide a valuation, but this work is ongoing as at the date of this report, and in any event, disclosure of valuation information would be commercially sensitive in the event that a Sale Option is pursued.

GOPAL

- **Secured creditors** – There are no secured creditors.
- **Preferential creditors** – There are no preferential creditors.
- **Prescribed part** – As there is no creditor holding a floating charge over the assets of the Company, no prescribed part will be required to be set aside.
- **Unsecured creditors** – At this stage it is not possible to estimate with any degree of certainty the likely return to unsecured creditors. The GOPH Receiver has engaged a firm of property valuers, Taylor Byrne, to provide a valuation of the plantation, but this work is ongoing as at the date of this report, and in any event, disclosure of valuation information would be commercially sensitive in the event that a Sale Option were pursued. Furthermore, as highlighted above, the intercompany claim of GOPAL against GOPH (which is the only asset of GOPAL) ranks behind the claim of GOPL, which is likely to restrict the return to GOPAL's creditors as against the return to creditors of GOPL.

8 Administrators' Remuneration and Disbursements

Pre-administration fees

- 8.1 In accordance with Rule 2.33(2B), it should be noted that FTI invoiced total fees of £20,000 (plus VAT) in relation to insolvency advice (including preparation for our appointment as Administrators) provided to the Companies in the period immediately prior to the Companies entering Administration under an engagement letter with GOPL dated 9 April 2013. This amount was paid prior to Simon Kirkhope and Chad Griffin's appointments as Administrators. The work performed was an integral part of preparing to take the appointment as Administrators. Further detail on the pre-administration work performed by FTI can be found at Appendix C.
- 8.2 The fees that FTI accrued from undertaking pre-administration work for GOPL totalled £29,126 (plus VAT). Therefore, £9,126 (plus VAT) of fees remained outstanding at the date of appointment, approval for payment of which will be sought from the GOPL estate in due course. It should be noted that the payment of unpaid pre-administration costs as an expense

of the administration is (i) subject to approval under Rule 2 67A of the Insolvency Rules 1986, and (ii) is not part of these Proposals which are subject to approval under Paragraph 53 of Schedule B1 to the Act

- 8 3 We are not aware of any other costs or expenses incurred in relation to the Companies by another party qualified to act as an insolvency practitioner in the period prior to our appointment as Administrators

Post-appointment fees

- 8 4 It is proposed that the remuneration of the Administrators will be fixed with reference to the time spent by the Administrators' and their staff in carrying out the Administrations, in accordance with Rule 2 106 of the Insolvency Rules. The timing of the exit of the Administrations will depend on the strategy adopted, as described earlier in this report
- 8 5 We have attached a Time Analysis at Appendix F in accordance with the provisions of Statement of Insolvency Practice 9 ("SIP 9"), which provides details of the activity costs incurred by staff grade in the period from date of appointment to 31 May 2013. We propose seeking approval of both the amount and method of drawing of fees in accordance with the proposals outlined below (subject to availability of funds)
- 8 6 The Administrators have currently incurred time costs of £128,424 and £6,055 (net of VAT) in properly dealing with the administrations of GOPL and GOPAL respectively. The minimum time units charged are six minutes. No post-administration fees have yet been drawn
- 8 7 In addition, the Administrators have incurred Category 1 expenses of £1,210.40 and £47.09 in GOPL and GOPAL respectively as at the date of this Report, as well as Category 2 expenses of £2,465.00 in GOPL
- 8 8 Attached as Appendix G is additional information in relation to our policy on staffing, the use of sub-contractors, disbursements and details of our current charge out rates by staff grade

Fee approval

- 8 9 There are no secured creditors, and it is therefore proposed that a Creditors' Committee made up of representatives of unsecured creditors of GOPL be appointed. The Creditors' Committee will be requested to fix the basis of the administrator's remuneration (under Rule 2.106 of the Insolvency Rules 1986). In the absence of a Creditors' Committee, creditors will be asked to approve the basis of remuneration at a general meeting of creditors, or failing that, by application to court.
- 8 10 A copy of the 'Creditors' Guide to Administrators' Fees' is available at http://www.r3.org.uk/media/documents/publications/professional/Guide_to_Administrators_Fees_Nov2011.pdf
- 8 11 Alternatively, creditors can request a copy from us and we will provide a paper copy by post.
- 8 12 Creditors' attention is drawn to Appendix G of this report which shows extracts from the Rules detailing the ability of creditors to request further information in relation to the Administrators' fees or to challenge the Administrators' remuneration.

9 Statutory Matters

- 9 1 The centre of main interest of the Companies is the United Kingdom. Therefore, the EC Regulations on Insolvency Proceedings 2000 apply to the Administrations. The proceedings are main proceedings as defined by Article 3 of those regulations.
- 9 2 If approved by the requisite majority at a meeting of creditors, the Administrators' proposals are binding on all creditors, including those not present or represented at the meeting. For this reason, it is important that you read this document carefully, properly considering the proposals. A creditor is entitled to propose modifications to these proposals for the consideration by the Administrators and creditors.
- 9 3 In preparing this report, we have relied on information provided by the directors and management of the Companies and by other third parties. Our investigations are continuing and, accordingly, it has not been possible to verify all such information. Therefore, we take no responsibility for the accuracy and completeness of this information or otherwise.
- 9 4 We are required to provide a progress report to all creditors within one month of the end of the first six months of the Administrations, or when the Administrations come to an end, whichever is sooner.

10 Administrators' Proposals

10 1 As outlined above, the objectives of the Administrations are as follows

- a **GOPL** - achieving a better result for the company's creditors as a whole than would be likely if the company were wound up (without first being in administration),
- b **GOPAL** - achieving a better result for the company's creditors as a whole than would be likely if the company were wound up (without first being in administration),

10 2 The contents of this Report represent the Administrators' proposals. In order to provide clarity to creditors on the further specific areas for which the Administrators are seeking approval, we have subdivided our specific proposals into three subsections below

Proposed strategy, actions and activities

10 3 It is proposed that

- a the Administrators continue to manage the affairs of the Companies in order to achieve the purpose of the Administration
- b the Administrators do all such other things and generally exercise all of their powers as contained in Schedule B1 to the Act, as we consider desirable or expedient to achieve the statutory purpose of the Administration
- c the Administrators be authorised to advance funding to the GOPH Receiver to meet ongoing plantation operating costs (if, in the judgement of the Administrators, it is likely to enhance the return to creditors)
- d the Administrators implement either the Sale Option or the Restructuring Option or such other option as agreed with the Creditors' Committee (whichever, in the judgment of the Administrators, provides the best return for creditors, subject to the funding, regulatory and legal constraints of the Companies), in consultation with the Creditors' Committee (if one is formed)
- e the Administrators investigate and, as appropriate, pursue any claims that the Companies may have
- f the Administrators be authorised to agree the claims of the preferential and unsecured creditors against each of the Companies unless we conclude, in our reasonable opinion, that a Company will have no assets available for distribution

- g in relation to potential distributions to unsecured creditors, the Administrators, at our discretion, be entitled to make an application to court for permission to make distributions to unsecured creditors under Paragraph 65(3) of Schedule B1 of the Act
 - h in the event that the creditors of each Company so determine, a Creditors' Committee be appointed in respect of each or either Company comprising of not more than five and not less than three creditors of that Company
- 10 4 At this stage we do not consider there to be a need for a GOPAL Creditors' Committee given the likely return to GOPAL creditors. Furthermore, there are no funds available in the GOPAL estate to reimburse any reasonable expenses incurred by Committee members (should one be appointed). In the absence of a GOPAL Committee the Administrators will ensure that GOPAL Creditors are kept informed of wider developments.

Proposed Exit Routes

- 10 5 We cannot yet conclude on the likely exit route from Administration. The exit options which appear most likely at this stage are
- a the dissolution of the Companies,
 - b the Companies entering a liquidation process, or
 - c one or both of the Companies entering into a Company Voluntary Agreement (CVA) with their respective creditors, followed by a dissolution of the Companies or the Companies entering liquidation.
- 10 6 The Administrators will be discharged from liability in accordance with Paragraph 98(1) of Schedule B1 of the Act immediately upon their appointment as Administrators ceasing to have effect.
- 10 7 In event that the Court does not consent for a dividend to unsecured creditors of the Companies to be made by the Administrators, the Administrators will file a notice with the Registrar of Companies in order that the Administrations cease and the Companies move automatically into a Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation (a "CVL"). It is proposed that the Administrators would in this circumstance become the Joint Liquidators of the CVLs. Any act required or authorised under any enactment to be done by the Joint Liquidators would be able to be done by any one of them.
- 10 8 Creditors have the right to nominate an alternative liquidator of their choice. To do this, creditors must make their nomination in writing to the Administrators prior to these Proposals.

being approved. Where this occurs, the Administrators will advise all creditors and provide them the opportunity to vote. In the absence of an alternative nomination, the Administrators will automatically become the Joint Liquidators of the subsequent CVLs of the Companies.

Administrators' remuneration

10.9 It is proposed that

- a the Creditors' Committee for each Company, if one is appointed under Rule 2.106(5) of IA 1986, be asked to (i) agree that the basis of the Administrators' remuneration be fixed by reference to the time properly given by the Administrators' and their staff in attending to matters arising in the Administrations, calculated at the prevailing standard hourly charge out rates used by FTI at the time when the work is performed, plus VAT, and (ii) agree the Administrators' category 2 expenses
- b if a Creditors' Committee is not appointed, a resolution of the unsecured creditors in meeting be sought to fix the remuneration of the administrators (in accordance with Rule 2.106(5) of IA 1986). If the creditors' meeting fails to do so, the Administrators must then apply to court to establish the basis of their remuneration (Rule 2.106(6)).
- c The Administrators (acting as agents of GOPL in its capacity as secured creditor of GOPH) will approve the Australian Receiver fees, in consultation with the Creditors' Committee (should one be appointed).

Additional Information in Relation to Administrators' Fees Pursuant to Statement of Insolvency Practice 9

Detailed below is FTI's policy in relation to

- staff allocation and the use of sub-contractors,

1.1 Staff Allocation and the use of Sub-contractors

Our general approach to resourcing our assignments is to allocate staff with the skills and experience to meet the specific requirements of the case

The constitution of the case team will usually consist of a Senior Managing Director, Managing Director, Director, Senior Consultant and Consultant. The exact constitution of the case team will depend on the anticipated size and complexity of the assignment and on larger, more complex cases, several Senior Consultants/Consultants may be allocated to meet the demands of the case

With regard to support staff, we would advise that time spent by cashiers in relation to specific tasks on an assignment is charged. Only if there is a large block of time incurred by a member of the secretarial team, eg, report compilation and distribution, do we seek to charge and recover our time in this regard

1.2 Professional Advisors

Our choice was based on our view of their experience and ability to perform this type of work, the complexity and nature of the assignment and the basis of our fee arrangement with them.

Further, it was important that professional advisors had a local presence and expertise in relevant geographies e.g. Queensland Australia and/or the UK.

1.3 Disbursements

Category 1 disbursements do not require approval by creditors. The type of disbursements that may be charged as a Category 1 disbursement to a case generally comprise of external supplies of incidental services specifically identifiable to the case, such as postage, case advertising, invoiced travel and external printing, room hire and document storage. Also chargeable will be any properly reimbursed expenses incurred by personnel in connection with the case.

Category 2 disbursements do require approval from creditors. These disbursements can include costs incurred which relate to payments due to associated companies for the provision of services to the office holder. On this case certain FTI Technology costs are likely to be considered as Category 2 disbursements and therefore requisite creditor approvals will be sought.

1.1 Rule 2.48A - Creditors' request for further information

(1) If –

- (a) Within 21 days of receipt of a progress report under Rule 2.47 –
 - (i) a secured creditor, or
 - (ii) an unsecured creditor with the concurrence of at least 5% in value of the unsecured creditors (including the creditor in question) or
- (b) with the permission of the court upon an application made within that period of 21 days, any unsecured creditor,

makes a request in writing to the administrator for further information about remuneration or expenses (other than pre-administration costs) set out in a statement required by Rule 2.47(1)(db) or (dc), the administrator must, within 14 days of receipt of the request, comply with paragraph (2)

(2) The administrator complies with this paragraph by either—

- (a) providing all of the information asked for, or
- (b) so far as the administrator considers that—
 - (i) the time or cost of preparation of the information would be excessive, or
 - (ii) disclosure of the information would be prejudicial to the conduct of the administration or might reasonably be expected to lead to violence against any person, or
 - (iii) the administrator is subject to an obligation of confidentiality in respect of the information,

giving reasons for not providing all of the information

(3) Any creditor, who need not be the same as the creditor who requested further information under paragraph (1), may apply to the court within 21 days of—

- (c) the giving by the administrator of reasons for not providing all of the information asked for, or

and the court may make such order as it thinks just

1.2 Rule 2.109 - Creditors' claim that remuneration is [or other expenses are] excessive

(1) Any secured creditor, or any unsecured creditor with either the concurrence of at least 10% in value of the unsecured creditors (including that creditor) or the permission of the court, may apply to the court for one or more of the orders in paragraph (4)

(1A) An application may be made on the grounds that—

- (a) the remuneration charged by the administrator,
- (b) the basis fixed for the administrator's remuneration under Rule 2.106,
- (c) expenses incurred by the administrator,

is or are in all the circumstances, excessive, or in the case of an application under sub-paragraph (b), inappropriate

(1B) The application must, subject to any order of the court under Rule 2.48A(4), be made no later than 8 weeks after receipt by the applicant of the progress report which first reports the charging of the remuneration or the incurring of the expenses in question ("the relevant report")

- (2) The court may, if it thinks that no sufficient cause is shown for a reduction, dismiss it without a hearing but it shall not do so without giving the applicant at least 5 business days' notice, upon receipt of which the applicant may require the court to list the application for a without notice hearing. If the application is not dismissed, the court shall fix a venue for it to be heard, and give notice to the applicant accordingly.
- (3) The applicant shall, at least 14 days before the hearing, send to the administrator a notice stating the venue and accompanied by a copy of the application, and of any evidence which the applicant intends to adduce in support of it.
- (4) If the court considers the application to be well-founded, it must make one or more of the following orders—
- (1) an order reducing the amount of remuneration which the administrator was entitled to charge,
 - (2) an order fixing the basis of remuneration at a reduced rate or amount,
 - (3) an order changing the basis of remuneration,
 - (4) an order that some or all of the remuneration or expenses in question be treated as not being expenses of the administration,
 - (5) an order that the administrator or the administrator's personal representative pay to the company the amount of the excess of remuneration or expenses or such part of the excess as the court may specify,
- and may make any other order that it thinks just, but an order under sub-paragraph (b) or (c) may be made only in respect of periods after the period covered by the relevant report.
- (5) Unless the court orders otherwise, the costs of the application shall be paid by the applicant, and are not payable as an expense of the administration.
