REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 May 2023

The trustees who are also directors of the charity for the purposes of the Companies Act 2006, present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 May 2023. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The main purpose of the company during the period was to raise sufficient funds through the selling of used clothes to provide grants to hospitals and hospices for the preservation of children health, consistent with the Memorandum objects clause.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust, and constitutes a limited company, limited by guarantee, as defined by the Companies Act 2006.

Recruitment and appointment of new trustees

The directors of the company are also charity trustees for the purposes of Charity law. The members of the Management Committee are elected and retire by rotation after which they must be re-elected at the next Annual General Meeting.

Organisational structure

The Chief Executive is responsible for ensuring that the charity delivers the services specified and that the key performance indicators are met.

Help sick children has a Management Committee of 3 members who meet regularly and are responsible for the strategic direction and policy of the charity.

Members of the Management Committee are directors for the purposes of company law and trustees for the purposes of charity law.

Induction and training of new trustees

Most trustees are already familiar with the practical work of the charity having been encouraged to be actively engaged. Additionally, new trustees are invited and encouraged to attend any training sessions to familiarise themselves with the charity and the context to which it operates, these are jointly led by the Chair of the Management Committee and the Chief Executive of the charity and cover:

- The Obligations of the Management Committee members
- The main documents which set out the operational framework for the charity including the Memorandum and Articles of Association.
- Resourcing and the current financial position as set out in the latest published accounts.
- Future plans and objectives.

Related parties

There were no related party transaction, except in so far as it is complimentary to the charity objects; the charity is guided by both local and national policy with particular regard to the welfare of children.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charitable company, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
