THE ADMINISTRATOR'S PROGRESS REPORT

1 Introduction

- 1 1 I, together with my colleague Gemma Louise Roberts, was re-appointed as Joint Administrator of the Company on 15 November 2013 The appointment was made by Team O Solutions Limited ("Team O") of Warwick Road, Maltby, Rotherham S66 8EW, who hold a qualifying floating charge over the Company's assets
- Following conclusion of the original Administration, further information became available which improved the recoverability of a significant book debt due to the Company Accordingly, the Company was placed back into Administration in November 2013 in order to facilitate the recovery of the debt. Creditors should note the process utilised the previous Administration's Court Reference number.
- This Administration is being handled by Wilson Field Limited ("Wilson Field") at The Manor House, 260 Ecclesall Road South, Sheffield S11 9PS. The Administration is registered in the Leeds District Registry, reference number 268 of 2012.
- 1 4 In April 2016, the Joint Administrators successfully made an application to Court to extend the Administration term to 13 May 2017
- The trading address of the Company was Pearl Business and Enterprise Park, Sandback Way, Hellaby Industrial Estate, Rotherham S66 8QL however this was subsequently changed to c/o Wilson Field, the Manor House, 260 Ecclesall Road South, Sheffield S11 9PS on the appointment of the Joint Administrators
- 1 6 The Company's registered number is 07299851
- As Joint Administrator, I am required to provide a progress report covering the period of six months commencing from the date the Company entered Administration and every subsequent period of six months. This progress report covers the period from 18 May 2016 to 17 November 2016 ("the Period") and should be read in conjunction with my earlier proposals report and any previous progress reports which have been issued.

2 Progress of the Administration

- You may recall that the statutory objective being pursued in the Administration was to relaise property in order to make a distribution to one or more secured or preferential creditors. In addition to the pursuance of this statutory objective, the Joint Administrators have duties imposed by insolvency and other legislation, some of which may not provide any financial benefit to creditors.
- This section of the report provides creditors with an update on the progress made in the Period, both in terms of the achievement of the statutory objective, but also work which is required of the Joint Administrators under other related legislation
- At appendix A is my R&P covering the Period, together with a cumulative R&P from the date of my appointment as Joint Administrator to 17 November 2016
- Attached at appendix B is a time analysis outlining the time spent by the Joint Administrators and their staff during the Period, together with a cumulative time analysis covering the period since my appointment at appendix C
- 2.5 Further information about the basis of remuneration agreed in this case can be found in section 4 of this report

Joint Administrators' Progress Report

Realisation of assets

- As previously advised, the Company's only remaining asset is a book debt due to the Company with a potentially realisable value of £66,000 to £121,000. The Joint Administrators have instructed a firm of construction debt recovery agents, Contract Recovery Solutions Limited ("CRS") to liaise with the debtor (Carillion) in order to recover the sums due. As payment was not forthcoming, Stripes Solicitors Limited ("Stripes") were instructed to commence legal proceedings.
- 2.7 Correspondence between Stripes and Carillion ensued, unfortunately however, due to the complexities of the debt and the lack of availability of key members of the Company's staff, there have been delays in finalising the position and the debt remains outstanding

Creditors (claims and distributions)

- Further information on the anticipated outcome for creditors in this case can be found at section 5 of this report. The Administrators are not only required to deal with correspondence and claims from unsecured creditors (which may include retention of title claims), but also those of any secured and preferential creditors of the Company. This may involve separate reporting to any secured creditor and dealing with distributions from asset realisations caught under their security, most typically a debenture.
- 2 9 Claims from preferential creditors typically involve employee claims and payments made on behalf of the Company by the Redundancy Payments Service following dismissal
- The above work will not necessarily bring any financial benefit to creditors generally, however the Joint Administrators are required by statute to undertake this work. Similarly, if a distribution is to be paid to any class of creditor, work will be required to agree those claims and process the dividend payments to each relevant class of creditor. The more creditors a company has, the more time and cost will be involved by the Joint Administrators in dealing with those claims.

Investigations

2 11 Shortly after appointment, I made an initial assessment of whether there could be any matters that might lead to recoveries for the estate and what further investigations may be appropriate. This assessment took into account information provided by creditors either at the initial meeting (where held) or as a response to my request to complete an investigation questionnaire. My investigations have not revealed any issues requiring further report or any further potential recoveries which could be pursued for the benefit of creditors.

3 Pre-administration costs

3 1 On 27 January 2014 creditors approved the Joint Administrators' pre-administration costs of £1,709 This fee has been drawn in full

4 Joint Administrators' remuneration

- The basis of the Joint Administrators' fees has been fixed in the Administration by reference to the time properly spent by them and their staff in managing the Administration, limited to £15,000 plus VAT
- My time costs for the Period are £2,278 This represents 8.1 hours at an average rate of £281 per hour. Attached at appendix B is a time analysis which provides details of the activity costs incurred by staff grade during the Period in respect of the costs fixed by reference to time properly spent in managing the Administration. To date, £2,500 plus VAT plus disbursements of £5.068 has been drawn on account.

- Also attached at appendix C is a cumulative time analysis for the period from 15 November 2013 to 17 November 2016 which provides details of my time costs since my appointment. The cumulative time costs incurred to date are £31,704 and this represents 120 hours at an average rate of £284 per hour.
- In considering the remaining work to be done in this Administration, I currently anticipate that my time costs to complete the Administration will be approximately £20,000 I will update creditors on this in my next progress report

5 Estimated outcome for creditors

Secured creditors

As advised Team O hold a debenture incorporating fixed and floating charges over the Company's assets. The debenture was created on 4 May 2011 and registered at Companies House on 6 May 2011. At the date of the Administration the indebtedness to the secured creditor was estimated at £360,687. To date no payment has been made to Team O in respect of their security.

Preferential creditors

The Joint Administrators do not anticipate any preferential claims would be made in the Administration I would confirm that to date, none have been made

Unsecured creditors

- I have received claims totalling £385,239 from nine creditors. I have yet to receive claims from thirty six creditors whose debts total £1,145,130 as per the Company's statement of affairs.
- As advised the Company granted a floating charge to Team O on 4 May 2011 accordingly, I am required to create a fund out of the Company's net floating charge property for unsecured creditors known as the Prescribed Part ("PP")
- Based on present information, I estimate that a PP will be made available to unsecured creditors, however this is dependent on the outcome of the aforementioned book debt collections

6 Ending the Administration

- As advised in previous reports, the Joint Administrators anticipate that they will file a requisite notice pursuant to Para 83 of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency act 1986 ("the Act"), moving the Company into Creditors Voluntary Liquidation ("CVL") in order to facilitate a distribution to the Company's unsecured creditors via the PP
- Should the Company move to CVL, Gemma Roberts and I will become the Company's Joint Liquidators. The Joint Administrators will be discharged from liability under paragraph 98(3) of schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986 immediately upon their appointment as Administrators ceasing to have effect.
- However, should the Joint Administrators conclude that the Company's property is insufficient to enable any further distributions to any of its creditors, a notice pursuant to section 84(1) of Schedule B1 of the Act will be filed, seeking the dissolution of the Company

7 Creditors' rights

- 7 1 Within 21 days of the receipt of this report, a secured creditor, or an unsecured creditor (with the concurrence of at least 5% in value of the unsecured creditors) may request in writing that the Joint Administrators provide further information about their remuneration or expenses (other than pre-administration costs) which have been itemised in this progress report
- Any secured creditor, or an unsecured creditor (with the concurrence of at least 10% in value of the unsecured creditors) may within 8 weeks of receipt of this progress report make an application to court on the grounds that, in all the circumstances, the basis fixed for the Joint Administrators' remuneration is inappropriate and/or the remuneration charged or the expenses incurred by the Joint Administrators, as set out in this progress report, are excessive

8 Next report

The Joint Administrators are required to provide a progress report within one month of the end of the next six months of the Administration or earlier if the Administration has been finalised or they wish to extend it
