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**ORDER**

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**UPON THE APPLICATION OF THE APPLICANT** dated 2 April 2019

**AND UPON** the consent of Rendall Thompson

**AND UPON** the Court considering that the order can be made without hearing

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The insolvency appointments set out in the Schedule to this application be transferred to the High Court of Justice, Business and Property Courts of England and Wales, Chancery Division, for the purpose only of making the order sought in this application pursuant to Rule 12.30(7) of the Rules.
2. In relation to all the cases listed in Schedule the Applicant be appointed in place of the Respondent as office holder.
3. Immediately upon this order taking effect, the insolvency appointments listed in the Schedule be transferred back to the court from which they were transferred (where applicable).
4. The Applicant does at the first opportunity and in any event within 14 days of the date of the Order, give notice of the Order, by advertisement in the Gazette to all creditors (and in the case of members voluntary liquidations, the members), in the cases listed in the Schedule.
5. The Applicant does at the first opportunity and in any event within 14 days of the date of the Order, give notice of the Order to the Secretary of State and the Registrar of Companies.

6. The Applicant does at the first opportunity and in any event within 21 days of the date of the Order lodge a sealed copy of the Order at any District Registry or County Court where a case listed in the Schedule is pending.
7. The Estate of the Respondent shall receive his release as liquidator, trustee or supervisor (as specified in the Schedule) 56 days after filing notification of the Order with the Secretary of State and/or Registrar of Companies as provided for in paragraph 5 save that such release may be subject to further order in the event of an application by any creditor or member under paragraph 8 of this Order for the specific case subject to that application.
8. The creditor or, in the case of any members' voluntary liquidation, any member in any cases listed in identified in the Schedule should have liberty to apply to this Court within 56 days of notice of the Order made pursuant to this application having been given in accordance with paragraph 4 above.
9. Pursuant to Rule 1.3 and Schedule 3 of the Rules and Rule 3.1(2)(a) of the Civil Procedure Rules 1998 (as amended) and in respect of each of the cases listed in the Schedule, the time by which progress reports are required to be delivered by the Applicant pursuant to the Rules and/or the Insolvency Act 1986 following the Order be extended or shortened as is applicable to the date on which such progress reports would have been required in each matter had this Order not been made.
10. The costs and expenses of and incidental to the Application to be paid as an expense of the bankruptcy, the IVA or the liquidation, to be apportioned between each listed in the Schedule.
