FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH SEPTEMBER 2017

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The following account policies have been consistently applied in dealing with items which are considered material to the company's accounts.

Basis of preparation

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost accounting rules and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard 102 Section 1A- 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Companies Act 2006.

Income

The company is a non profit making entity responsible for the running and development of the game of cricket in Oxfordshire and derives its income from various cricket, education and community boards by way of grants, donations and fundraising activities

Fixed assets and depreciation

The company accounts for the cost of equipment expensed through its Income and Expenditure Account in the year of purchase and no depreciation is charged thereon.

Leases

All leases are accounted for as "operating leases" and the rental charged to the Income and Expenditure Account on a straight line basis over the life of the lease.
