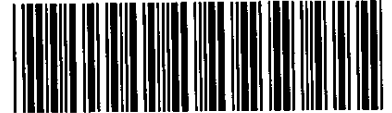

UPON THE APPLICATION by a Claim Form dated the 25th April 2019 of  
Iridium Bidco Limited a Claimant and the sole member of the above named  
Lausanne Topco Limited (hereinafter called "the Company")

AND UPON THE APPLICATION of Iridium Bidco Limited to add Simon Cox, a  
director of the Company, as a second Claimant to these proceedings

AND UPON READING the evidence

AND IT APPEARING that there is no opposition on behalf of Her Majesty to  
the relief sought by this Claim as appears from the waiver letter from the Treasury  
Solicitor dated the 11<sup>th</sup> June 2019.

AND upon the Claimants by their Solicitors undertaking that:

- (A) the Company will not carry on business or operate in any way other  
than to take the necessary steps to:
- (i) amend the Group Tax relief claim as referred to in paragraph  
54 of the Witness Statement of Richard Alexander Buchan  
Smith dated the 8<sup>th</sup> April 2019; and

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- (ii) settle all outstanding debts to its existing creditors, if any; (the actions) according to law
- (B) they will notify the Registrar of Companies immediately on the conclusion of the actions
- (C) the directors of the Company or a majority of them will immediately on the expiry of 3 months from the conclusion of the actions apply to the Registrar of Companies for the voluntary strike off of the Company under Section 1003 of the Companies Act 2006 and comply with all the relevant requirements for such an application

AND UPON the solicitors for the Claimants and for the Registrar of Companies (the Defendant) both consenting to this Order

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- (1) Permission is given to add Simon Cox to these proceedings and amend the Claim Form in the form appended to this Order pursuant to CPR 17 1, 19.2 and 19.4
- (2) the name of the above named Lausanne Topco Limited be restored to the Register of Companies
- (3) if at the date of registration of this Order with the Registrar of Companies the name of the Company is not available the Registrar of Companies shall pursuant to Section 1033(2)(a)(ii)

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and (b) of the Companies Act 2006 change the name of the Company to 07479143 Limited

- (3) an Office Copy of the Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to the above mentioned Act the Company is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off
- (4) the Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in her official name in the "London Gazette"
- (5) the Claimants do jointly and severally pay to the Registrar of Companies her costs of the said Application in the agreed sum of £300-00
- (6) the hearing fixed for the 1st August 2019 at 2:00pm be vacated
