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REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 JANUARY 2019

The trustees who are also directors of the charity for the purposes of the Companies Act 2006, present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 January 2019. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Charitable Objectives

The relief and prevention of poverty, and the relief of need in particular by the provision of food and other care for the poor.

Review of activities

During the year, large numbers of donors have continued to give us their food, many on a regular basis. With additional food bought using cash donations, we were able to feed an average of 60 households every week (2018 - 62 households) sufficient to make over 87,000 basic meals (2018 - 90,000 meals).

On behalf of the beneficiaries the trustees express their heartfelt thanks to all their fundraisers, donors, unpaid volunteers from various Catholic and Church of England communities, who purchased, stored, packed and transported food steadfastly every week.

We are pleased to record our thanks to The Montfort Missionaries at St Joseph's Ashurst for providing storage, transport and administrative facilities all without charge. In addition, we express our gratitude to the team who manned the emergency communications network and in particular our volunteer drivers for freely providing their own transport.

There were no administration costs, and we are proud to say that 100% of donations were used or are available in reserve for feeding beneficiaries.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document and constitutes a limited company, limited by guarantee as defined by the Companies Act 2006. The company adopted the model articles of association of charitable companies as endorsed by the Charities Commission.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 JANUARY 2019

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charitable company have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRSSE) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (the FRSSE) (effective 1 January 2015)', the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015) and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
