# Instant IT Help Articles of Association

#### Purpose of Company:

Instant IT Help (hereinafter referred to as business) is a private limited company incorporated under the laws of the United Kingdom that provides remote computer support services via the Internet to individuals and small and medium-sized businesses in the United Kingdom and throughout the world

#### Statement of Limited Liability:

Instant IT Help is a company limited by shares and all directors have limited liability

#### Principal Office:

The principal office of the business is located in Euxton, Lancashire in the United Kingdom

#### 2 Names of Directors:

Instant IT Help has two directors, Bert Oosthuizen and Marc Krieger

#### 3. Director Meetings:

The directors will meet quarterly to discuss the state of the business, distribution of dividends, and other relevant matters. Before adjourning each meeting, the directors will determine the date, time, and location of the next meeting.

#### 4 Specific Duties and Contributions of Each Director:

- A. Financial Contributions: Marc Krieger will contribute an initial investment of 5,000 pounds as a no-interest loan to the business. The business will repay the loan within one year from the date of issuance. As consideration for the loan and in lieu of interest, Marc Krieger will receive a 5% ownership stake in the business in addition to repayment of principal.
- **B. Ownership Stake:** Bert Oosthuizen has a 95% ownership stake and Marc Krieger has a 5% ownership stake
- C. Bert Oosthuizen's Duties: Bert Oosthuizen will serve as managing director who will oversee the day to day operation of the business and has express authority over all business matters including but not limited to the technical aspects, sales and marketing, contracts, taxes, legal financial, HR, purchasing, etc
- **D.** Marc Krieger's Duties: Marc Krieger will serve as a director who will provide financing and advisory help to the business

#### 5. Director Residency:

- A. Bert Oosthuizen is a UK resident who plans to remain in the United Kingdom permanently
- B. Marc Krieger is a United States citizen temporarily residing in the United Kingdom to assist with the initial formation of the business. After the business formation, Marc Krieger will immigrate to New Zealand and will handle his duties as director from New Zealand.

#### 6. Distribution of Profits:

The directors agree that all incoming money will enter the business as income and that the business will pay expenses before distributing any dividends or profits. The directors will determine quarterly how much of the profits they will reinvest into the business and how much they will distribute as dividends.

#### 7. Addition of New Directors:

The business will only add directors with the approval of Bert Oosthuizen and Marc Krieger In the event that the business adds more directors in the future, new directors can only obtain admission with a unanimous vote of the existing directors.

#### 8. Death of a Director, Buying Out a Director's Share, Transfer of Ownership:

- A. In the event that one of the directors dies, the ownership interest will transfer completely to the deceased director's estate
- B. In the event that the directors jointly decide to end their relationship, the directors will each hire a qualified business appraiser to determine the value of the business. The two appraisers will jointly appoint a third appraiser. Each of the three appraisers will appraise the business. The outgoing director will receive his ownership percentage of the mean of the three appraisals.
- C. No director may transfer his ownership share to another individual or entity without the express and unanimous approval of all existing directors

#### 9. Authority over Bank Accounts, Contracts, Books Etc:

- A. Bert Oosthuizen will have complete control over bank accounts, financials, contracts, etc
- **B.** Each director has the authority to examine the company's books at any time and without prior notice

#### 10. Amendments:

The directors agree that they may amend these original Articles of Association at any time for whatever reason with the written and unanimous approval of the directors. The directors will amend the Articles of Association to reflect the new provisions

#### 11. Items Not Covered by Articles of Association:

In the event that these Articles of Association do not cover a specific area of business operation, the directors will meet and resolve the issue themselves by unanimous agreement

#### 12. Conflict Resolution:

In the unlikely event that a disagreement arises between the directors, both directors agree to mediate the matter jointly and with good faith. In the event that they are unable to resolve the disagreement, the directors will hire a mediator. Should mediation prove unfruitful, the directors will hire an arbitrator, whose decision is binding and not subject to review by any judicial tribunal. If the directors cannot agree on an arbitrator, the partners will each appoint one arbitrator and the two arbitrators will decide on a third arbitrator who will adjudicate their dispute. The directors agree that they will only employ the procedure for adjudicating disputes outlined in this contract and they waive their right to judicial relief
