1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The company meets its day to day working capital requirements through a loan facility which is repayable over a term which ends in 2016. The company expects to operate within this facility.

The company will also be dependent on the continued financial support of the directors who have agreed to provide such support to ensure the company will be able to trade as a going concern for the foreseeable future.

Accordingly, the financial statements have been prepared on the going concern basis.

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

Turnover

Turnover represents rents received from properties owned by the company.

Investment property

Investment properties are shown at the most recent valuation. Any aggregate surplus or deficit arising from changes in market value is transferred to a revaluation reserve. In accordance with SSAP 19 'Accounting for Investment Properties', no depreciation is provided in respect of these properties. This is a departure from the Companies Act 2006 which requires all properties to be depreciated. Such properties are not held for use within the business but for investment and the directors consider that it would not be appropriate to depreciate them. The directors consider that this policy presents a true and fair view.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.
