DRAFT ORDER

UPON the application notice of the Applicant dated 4 May 2021

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Each of the insolvency appointments set out in the attached schedule in respect of which the County Court currently has jurisdiction be transferred to the High Court of Justice, Business and Property Courts at Liverpool for the purpose of this Application only pursuant to rule 12.37(1)(a) of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 ("Rules").
2. In relation to the creditors' voluntary liquidations identified in part 1 of the Schedule, the Applicant be removed from office as liquidator with effect from the date of the order pursuant to section 108 of the 1986 Act and rule 12.37(1)(c) of the Rules.
3. In relation to the bankruptcies identified in part 2 of the Schedule, the Applicant be removed from office as trustee in bankruptcy with effect from the date of this order pursuant to section 298 of the 1986 Act and rule 12.37(1)(c) of the Rules.
4. The First and Second Respondents be appointed as replacement office holders in respect of each of the insolvency appointments listed in parts 1 and 2 of the schedule with effect from the date of this order.

5. Immediately upon this order taking effect, the insolvency appointments set out in the schedule be transferred back to the County Court from which they were transferred.
6. The Applicants shall as soon as reasonably practicable and in any event within 28 days of the date of the order, give notice of this order by advertisement in the London Gazette and, at the time of the next statutory reporting required to all creditors of the matters listed in the Schedule, the Secretary of State, and in respect of the companies in the Schedule to the Register of Companies.
7. The Applicant shall as soon as reasonably practicable and in any event within 28 days of the date of the order, lodge a sealed copy of the order at any District Registry or County Court where a case listed in the Schedule is pending.
8. The Applicant shall as soon as reasonably practicable and in any event within 28 days of the date of the order, serve a sealed copy of the order on the Respondents.
9. Any creditor, in respect of any of the companies or persons listed in the Schedule who has an objection to this order shall have 21 days from the date of the advertisement placed in the London Gazette to apply to Court to set aside or vary the terms of this order. Such application shall not affect the transfer of the Block Transfer cases until further order by the Court.
10. There be no order as to costs of this application.
11. The Applicant shall receive his release as liquidator 28 days after filing notice of the Applicant's removal with the Registrar of Companies in accordance with the terms of paragraph 6 of this order, save that such release may be subject to further order in the event of an application by a creditor under paragraph 9 of this order for the specific case subject to that application.
12. The Applicant shall receive his release as trustee in bankruptcy 28 days after giving notice of the Applicant's removal to creditors in accordance with the terms of paragraph 6 of this order, save that such release may be subject to further order in the event that an application by a creditor under paragraph 9 of this order for the specific case subject to the Application.
