### ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

During the twelve months to July 2015 the charity received a further £9,454 in grants and donations (2014: £55,398) this has enabled the trustees to continue with the planned development of the gardens.

### FINANCIAL REVIEW

The charity has made a deficit for the year of £956 (2014: surplus £2,403). All donations and grants received are used for the further development of the gardens on a timely basis. The charity carries out the work on the gardens in phases and only incurs expenditure for monies previously received.

#### PLANS FOR FUTURE PERIODS

The development of the gardens has continued during the remainer of 2015 and into 2016 with the installation of new benches and further planting.
