Progress in the Liquidation

Asset realisations

Receipts and payments accounts are attached at Appendix C. As expected, no assets have been realised in the liquidations.

The Companies' sole assets were debtor balances owed by group companies, and these balances have been distributed to the Companies' member on 22 January 2024.

Creditors

There were no known creditors at the date of liquidation. Following our appointment, statutory advertisements were placed in the London Gazette and Times newspaper inviting creditors to submit their claims. No claims have been received to date.

The Companies were all removed from a VAT group prior to our appointment, and Exploration (Luderitz Basin) Limited was dormant for corporation tax purposes. The corporation tax returns for pre-liquidation periods for the other two Companies were filed by their parent group in September 2023. We have now received clearances from HMRC that they have no objection to the liquidations being concluded.

Return on capital

As stated above, first and final distributions in specie of the intercompany balances were made to the Companies' sole member on 22 January 2024.

Other matters

In addition to the above matters, we have dealt with all statutory matters required by legislation and administrative work incidental to our duties as Joint Liquidators.
