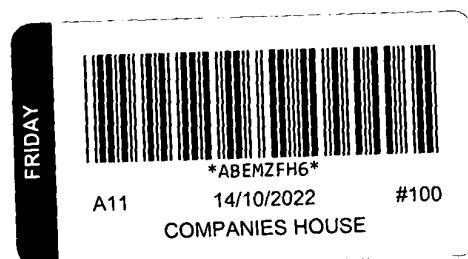

3. The Resolution is a special resolution and, to be passed, requires members holding at least 75% or more of the total voting rights of eligible members to vote in favour of it.



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
