Accounting Policies;

Basis of Accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and are in accordance with aoolicable accounting standards. The accounting policies have been applied consistently throught the year.

1 FUND ACCOUNTING

Unrestricted funds are expendable at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance of the general objectives of the charitable company,

Restricted funds are subjected to restrictions on the expenditure imposed by the donor or through the terms of an appeal.

Designated funds are set aside ,from within the unrestricted fund, by the trustees for a particular purpose.

2 INCOMING RESOURCES

All incoming resources are included in the Statement of Financial Activities when the charitable company is legally entitled to the income and the amount can quantified with reasonable accuracy.

Rental income

Income generated from the hire of the hall and meeting rooms for the use to provide charitable social, recreational and educational activities. This include hire for private parties and events by local residents.

3. Resources Expanded:

Expenditure is recognised on an accrual basis as a liability is incurred. Expenditure includes and VAT which cannot be full recovered, and is reported as part of the expenditure to which it relates.

4. Premises:

Ted Ball Hall Community Association operates from premises owned by London Borough of Barking and Dagenham, which it occupies for a peppercorn rent.

5. Payments to Trustees

The Trustees neither received nor waived any emoluments during the year.

Trustees were entitled to reimbursement for expenses incurred as part of their trusteeship.
