NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2016

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

These accounts have been prepared on a going concern basis. The company is a not for profit organisation and as such the company's assets and liabilities shall be applied solely in furtherance of its purpose.

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015).

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Income

Members' fees and subscriptions are accounted for as income in the period to which they relate. All other revenues are recorded as earned or as the services are performed.

2. GOING CONCERN

The balance sheet discloses net liabilities of £20,493 compared to net assets of £nil in 2015. The company is engaged in the new HCA programme and will repay creditors during the forthcoming financial year.

As the company has received over £50,000 in members contributions since 31 March 2016, the directors have concluded that the company will be able to meet its liabilities as they fall due.
