#### 2. INTRODUCTION

- 2.1 A resolution to wind up the above Company was passed on 1 March 2012, when Kevin Lucas was appointed Liquidator
- This is the Third Annual Progress Report to members and covers the period from 1 March 2014 to 28 February 2015 and is issued pursuant to Section 92A of the Insolvency Act ("the Act") to provide members with an update on the progress of the Liquidation

#### 3. PROGRESS OF THE LIQUIDATION

Cash At Bank

As detailed in the Director's sworn Declaration of Solvency ("DOS"), the Company held cash at bank of £1,000 As at the date of this report, this amount was still outstanding, however, collection activity is ongoing

Leasehold Properties

As per the DoS, the Company held a number of leases with an estimated to realise value of £9,000. Efforts were made to seek sales or assignments of the leases, however, due to the economic climate this proved difficult to achieve. It is not anticipated realisations will now be received from these sources and we will look to conclude the liquidation.

**Future Realisations** 

With the exception of the above, no further realisations are anticipated and as soon as clearance is obtained from HM Revenue & Customs, the matter will be brought to a close

#### 4. RECEIPTS AND PAYMENTS ACCOUNT

4.1 A Receipts and Payments Account for the period is attached at Appendix 1

## 5. LIQUIDATOR'S REMUNERATION AND DISBURSEMENTS

- The basis upon which the Liquidator charges remuneration was agreed by members at the general meeting held on 1 March 2012. Members agreed that the Liquidator could draw remuneration based on a fixed fee basis, plus VAT and disbursements.
- The Liquidator's time costs during the period of this report are £1,442 50 and are shown in more detail in Appendix 2 This represents 5 90 hours at an average hourly rate of £244.49 Time has been mainly spent on general administration and planning
- 5.3 The Liquidator has not drawn any remuneration in the period of this report
- Disbursements incurred by the Liquidator are split into two categories. Category 1 disbursements are items of specific expenditure that are directly related to the case and are usually referable to an independent external supplier's invoice. All such items are charged to the case as they are incurred. Category 2 disbursements are items of incidental expenditure directly incurred on the case which include an element of shared or allocated cost and which are based on a reasonable method of calculation. Members have previously approved the payment of Category 1 disbursements at the meeting of members held on 1 March 2012.

- As required by Statement of Insolvency Practice Number 9, a schedule of the Liquidator's charge out rates and disbursement charging policies is shown at Appendix 3

- Under Rule 4 49E of the Rules the Liquidator is required to draw members' attention to Rule 4.148C, which provides that any member with at least 10% of the total voting rights of all the members having the right to vote at general meetings of the company, may no later than 8 weeks after receipt of the progress report make an application to the court on the grounds that the remuneration charged by the Liquidator, the basis fixed for the Liquidator's remuneration, or the expenses incurred by the Liquidator, are in the circumstances excessive or inappropriate
- 6. LIQUIDATOR'S EXPENSES
- 6.1 There have been no expenses incurred by the Liquidator during the reporting period

7 1 According to the DoS, the Company did not have any liabilities and no claims are anticipated

Outcome for Members

7.2 The Declaration of Solvency detailed that there would be a surplus of after paying the costs of Liquidation, however, as the leases have not been sold or re-assigned, there will be no realisations from this source, therefore, there will be no distribution to members

Statement under Rule 4 49E
