NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS for the year ended 5 April 2018

1. STATUTORY INFORMATION

Gallagher Family Investments Limited is a private company, limited by shares, registered in England and Wales. The company's registered number and registered office address can be found on the Company Information page.

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of Section 1A "Small Entities" of Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Going concern

The financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis as the directors have received confirmation of continuing support from Gallagher Family Limited Partnership and that the company expects future profits from the Partnership.

Taxation

Taxation for the year comprises current and deferred tax. Tax is recognised in the Income Statement, except to the extent that it relates to items recognised in other comprehensive income or directly in equity.

Current or deferred taxation assets and liabilities are not discounted.

Current tax is recognised at the amount of tax payable using the tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the balance sheet date.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Timing differences arise from the inclusion of income and expenses in tax assessments in periods different from those in which they are recognised in financial statements. Deferred tax is measured using tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the year end and that are expected to apply to the reversal of the timing difference.

Unrelieved tax losses and other deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that it is probable that they will be recovered against the reversal of deferred tax liabilities or other future taxable profits.

3. TAXATION

Analysis of the tax charge

No liability to UK corporation tax arose for the year ended 5 April 2018 nor for the year ended 5 April 2017.

The current corporation tax charge differs from the standard UK corporation tax rate applied to the result for the year. The differences are:

The Finance Act 2013 reduced the main rate of corporation tax to 20% from 1 April 2015. The Finance (No 2) Act 2015, which was substantively enacted on 26 October 2015, included provisions which reduced the main rate of corporation tax to 19% from 1 April 2017 and the Finance Act 2016, which was substantively enacted on 15 September 2016, included provisions which reduced the main rate of corporation tax to 17% from 1 April 2020. Accordingly, the current year tax charge has been provided for at a rate of 19% and deferred tax assets and liabilities have been provided for at rates between 17% and 20% depending on the expected date that the deferred tax assets or liabilities are expected to unwind.
