1. Accounting Policies

Basis of Accounting

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention as modified by the revaluation of certain fixed assets.

Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods, excluding Value Added Tax.

Stocks

Stocks and work in progress are valued at the lower of costs and net realisable value, after making due allowances for obsolete and slow moving items. Cost includes all direct expenditure and an appropriate proportion of fixed and variable overheads.

Depreciation

Depreciation is calculated to write off the cost or revalved amount less estimated residual value of fixed assets on a straight line basis over their estimated useful lives.

The following rates are used.

Equipment – 20% Reducing balance Computer - 20% Reducing balance

Deferred Taxation

Deferred tax arises as a result of including items of income and expenditure in taxation computations in periods different from those in which they are included in the company's accounts. Deferred tax is provided in full on timing differences which result in an obligation to pay more (or less) tax at a future date, at the average tax rates that are expected to apply when the timing differences reverse, based on current tax rates and laws.

Deferred tax is not provided on timing differences arising from the revaluation of fixed assets where there is no commitment to sell the asset.

Leased Assets

Rentals applicable to operating leases where substantially all of the benefits and risks of ownership remain with the lessor are charged against profit as incurred.

Assets held under finance leases and hire purchase contracts are capitalised and depreciated over their useful lives. The corresponding leases or hire purchase obligation is treated in the balance sheet as a liability. The interest element of rental obligation is charged to profit and loss account over the period of the lease as a constant proportion of the outstanding balance of capital repayments.

Pension Costs

Contributions in respect of the company's defined contribution pension scheme are charged to the profit and loss account for the year in which they are payable to the scheme.
