1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The going concern basis has been adopted in the preparation of these financial statements. The company's turnover for the period was £125 (2014 - £7,259) and the company recorded a loss of £17,418 (2014 - profit £3,037). Net cash surplus totalled £43 as at 30th November 2015 (2014 - £nil). The company is reliant on the continued support of its directors.

The directors acknowledge that there is a level of uncertainty in the general economic environment that may impact on the demand for the services the company supplies however based on the assessment of the business believe they are well placed to manage these business risks.

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015).

Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods, excluding value added tax.

Stocks

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.
