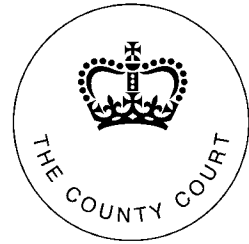

ORDER

UPON the application of Mr Lee Antony Manning, Mr Cameron Gunn and Mr Simon Jagger, as joint administrators of Festicket Ltd (in administration) (the “**Company**”), dated 28 July 2023 to extend the administration of the Company by 24 months to 11 September 2025 pursuant to paragraph 76(2)(a) of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986 (the “Application”)

AND UPON the order of Deputy ICC Judge Agnello KC dated 7 March 2023 and sealed on 19 April 2023 in claim number CR-2022-002837 (the “March Order”)

AND UPON the order of Chief ICC Judge Briggs on 31 July 2023 transferring this matter to the County Court

AND UPON the order of District Judge Hart dated 3 August 2023 listing this matter for a hearing on 7 September 2023

AND UPON reading the witness statement of Lee Antony Manning dated 28 July 2023 and the exhibit thereto

AND UPON hearing Miss Fiona Dewar of Counsel for the Joint Administrators

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The administration of the Company and the term in office of the Joint Administrators be extended until 11 September 2025 at 23:59 pursuant to paragraph 76(2)(a) of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986 and Rule 3.54 of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016.
2. The Joint Administrators be at liberty to apply for a further extension, if so advised.
3. As to costs:
 - (a) The Joint Administrators' costs of this application in the sum of £26,615.40 be payable as an expense in the administration, with creditors being at liberty to apply in relation to this sub-paragraph within 7 days of the Joint Administrators uploading a copy of this order and the relevant costs schedule to the "Document Sharing Platform" established pursuant to the March Order.
 - (b) It is hereby declared that the Berkeley Applegate allowance granted by paragraph 12 of the order of the March Order covers the Joint Administrators costs of this application in the sum of £13,307.70 (i.e., 50% of their total costs); and
 - (c) The Joint Administrators are permitted to immediately draw a payment on account of 80% of such allowance from the assets in their custody (i.e., in the sum of £10,646.16).
