OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES FOR THE PUBLIC BENEFIT

The objects of the charity are specifically restricted to the following:

To further or benefit the residents of Derwenlas, Glaspwll and the neighbourhood, without distinction of sex, sexual orientation, race or of political, religious or other opinions by associating together the said residents and the local authorities, voluntary and other organisations in a common effort to advance education and to provide facilities in the interests of social welfare for recreation leisure time occupation with the objective of improving the conditions of life for the residents.

In exercising their powers the trustees have complied with their duty to have due regard to the guidance on public benefit published by the Charity Commission.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

The Statement of Financial Activities shows total income of £4,130 and expenditure of £7,469 resulting in a deficit of £3,339.

TRUSTEES' RESPONSIBILITIES

The trustees are also company directors for the purpose of company law. Company law requires the directors to prepare financial statements for each financial year which give a true and fair view of the state of the company and of the surplus/deficit of the company for that period. In preparing these financial statements, the directors are required to:

select suitable accounting policies and apply them consistently; make judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and prepare the financial statements on a going concern basis, unless it is inappropriate to assume that the company will continue to operate.

The directors are responsible for keeping proper accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the company, and enable them to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Companies Act 2006. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the company, and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

1. Accounting Policies

a) Basis of Preparation of Financial Statements

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS102) (effective 1st January 2015) - (Charities SORP (FRS 102)), the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) and the Companies Act 2006.

Canolfan Cymunedol Derwenlas Community Centre meets the definition of a public benefit entity under FRS 102. Assets and liabilities are initially recognised at historical cost or transaction value unless otherwise stated in the relevant accounting policy.

b) Fund accounting

All funds are unrestricted funds which are available for use at the discretion of the directors in furtherance of the general objectives of the company.

c) Income

All income is recognised once the company has entitlement to the income, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount of income receivable can be measured reliably.

d) Expenditure

Expenditure is recognised once there is a legal or constructive obligation to transfer economic benefit to a third party, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is classified by the type of expenditure.

e) Creditors and Provisions

Creditors and provisions are recognised where the charity has a present obligation resulting from a past event that will probably result in the transfer of funds to a third party and the amount due to settle the obligation can be measured or estimated reliably.
