

The company has printed 10,000 one "Oliver" and 8,000 ten "Oliver" local currency vouchers 15,000 of these "Olivers" are now in circulation, providing discounts to local people and charity groups and increasing the sales of participating businesses

The company has recruited eighteen business that are accepting or offering goods and services in part or whole exchange for the "Bath Oliver" currency vouchers 147 Individual L E T S members are trading "olivers" between each other Four local charities are using "Olivers" to reward volunteer workers.

The development of the scheme has been carried out by a group of volunteers and the business members. Funding has been provided by a grant from Bath & North East Somerset waste services department, which used the "Oliver" as a reward for improved recycling rates among residents.

An information web site has been created for the scheme using the <a href="https://www.bathmoney.org">www.bathmoney.org</a> url This site provides public information on where to get and use the "Oliver "vouchers. The site can be accessed by the business members to advertise special "Oliver" offers. In addition the company has upgraded and redesigned the Bath LETS web site so members of the public can post their "Oliver" wants and offers online.

The company has attended several local business exhibitions and events to publicise the scheme and has developed attractive and recognisable publicity material. We also held an "Olivers" information evening at our agm on the 5th December to consult with current members of the scheme and recruit new members.
