1 Accounting Policies

Basis of measurement and preparation of accounts

Accounting convention:

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

Compliance with accounting standards:

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with applicable United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice), which have been applied consistently (except as otherwise stated).

Turnover:

Turnover represents amounts receivable for goods and services net of trade discounts.

Tangible fixed assets and depreciation:

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows: Fixtures, fitting & equipments 33.3% straight line

Revenue recognition:

Services provided during the year to clients, that at the balance sheet date have not yet been billed, are recognised as turnover in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 5 Application Note G "Revenue Recognition" and UITF Abstract 40 "Revenue Recognisition and Service Contracts". Turnover is recognised by reference to an assessment of fair value of the services provided at the balance sheet date, as a porportion of the total value of the engagement.
