NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MAY 2017

1. STATUTORY INFORMATION

Cafe Generation Limited is a private company, limited by shares, registered in England and Wales. The company's registered number and registered office address can be found on the company information page.

The financial statements are presented in sterling which is the functional currency of the company and rounded to the nearest pound.

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of Section 1A "Small Entities" of Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

This is the first year that the company has presented its financial statements under Financial Reporting Standard 102 (FRS102) issued by the financial Reporting Council. The last financial statements for the year ended 31 May 2016 were prepared under previous UK GAAP, and the transition date to FRS102 is therefore 1 June 2015.

Going Concern

The accounts have been prepared on a going concern basis as the directors' have indicated a willingness to support the company financially for the foreseeable future.

Significant judgements and estimates

No judgements have been made in the process of applying the below accounting policies that have had the most significant effect on amounts recognised in the financial statements.

There are no key assumptions concerning the future and other key sources of estimation uncertainty at the reporting date that have a significant risk of causing material adjustment to the carrying amounts of assets and liabilities within the next financial year.

Turnover

Turnover is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable, excluding discounts, rebates, value added tax and other sales taxes.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Plant and machinery - 20% on reducing balance Fixtures and fittings - 20% on reducing balance Motor vehicles - 20% on reducing balance
