We ran a young peoples' film making group in Alnwick, Northumberland, to devise and create short films about the impact of the pandemic on young people, with a special focus on mental health, supported by the national lottery community fund.

We continued our project about the 50th Anniversary of Northern stage. The project was funded by the Heritage Lottery fund & delivered in partnership with Northern Stage and Newcastle University. We ran weekly workshops in Newcastle, interviewing people who had been involved with the theatre over it's first 50 years.

We made a short film with a group in Peckham, supported by BBC Children in Need. This work was targeted at young people at risk of gang violence, raised awareness of issues around crime, provided diversionary activities during the school holiday & trained the young people in film making skills.

Working with Chiva, we made a short film about HIV with a particular focus on the experience of dDeaf people.

We were able to secure work placements for 13 young people on a feature film that was filmed in Alnwick.

The HIV project was written and conceived by young participants with lived experience of the issues.

The Peckham project was led by the participants in terms of content.
