- 2) The promotion of community participation in healthy recreation by the provision, or assistance in the provision, of facilities, coaching and equipment for the playing of sports, in particular but not exclusively in the sports of football, rugby, golf and athletics "

Nothing in the articles shall authorise an application of the property of the charity for purposes which are not charitable in accordance with section 7 of the Charities and Trustee investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and/or section 2 of the Charities Act (Northern Ireland) 2008

Section 8 of the Companies Act 2006 requires that the Memorandum of Association states that the company's subscribers

- (a) wish to form a company, and
- (b) agree to become members of the company

It also requires the members to authenticate the Memorandum of Association

in general, the Commission can accept any name but has the power to direct registered charity names to be changed in the circumstances set out in section 42(2) of the Charities Act 2011, which are explained in our guidance Registering as a Charity (CC21) and in our Operational Guidance (Names of chanties) available on our website in very broad terms, the name should not be offensive, or identical to (or too like) the name of any other charity, or likely to mislead the public about its purposes, activities, status, or connections. Some words and expressions are controlled under the Companies Act 2006 and other legislation A list of controlled words can be found in Appendices A - C of the Companies House website document 'incorporation and Names' (GP1)
