We are a Community Interest Company that aims to provide information, support and guidance to Hearing children that have d/Deaf parent(s), by means of activities, retreats and conferences

2014-2015 we hosted the CODA International Conference that saw 170 individuals from more than 15 different countries around the globe attend a weekend of activities we welcomed our under 18s to one of the days whereby they were able to meet with the international adult CODAs in attendance and have a memorable experience of their own. This has fostered relations internationally for both our adult and children activities and has increased the number of members and volunteers involved in our organisation as individuals see the importance of the work that we do. We also had our third CODA camp where we saw our numbers increase to 64 children and 13 adults. We maintained our two workshops in Derby and Stoke on Trent and were successful with maintaining funding, particularly that which we received from CODA International, for these as well as funding for our other projects and the numbers attending continue to grow as we look at expanding into other areas and future projects.

The stakeholders in this case, the Hearing children are consulted frequently during small group workshops on a monthly basis where issues requiring support concerning their Deaf culture are discussed and are permitted to choose what activities are undertaken. Feedback on temporary volunteer, permanent staff and services are encouraged to improve service and support, feedback is often discussed at board level and changes if needed implemented.

This year we have particularly focussed on obtaining feedback from our adult stakeholders, Hearing adults with deaf parents, in order to shape the CODA International conference, lead the conference and attend the conference as the ultimate beneficiaries this has then lead on to feedback generating future events focussed on adult CODAs

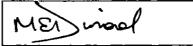
