

Report of the trustees (incorporating the directors' report) For the year ended 31st January 2014

The trustees present their report and the financial statements for the year ended 31st January 2014. The trustees, who are also directors of Northern Hope Gymnastics Club Ltd for the purposes of company law and who served during the year and up to the date of this report are set out on page 1.

Structure, governance and management

The organisation is a charitable company limited by guarantee and registered as a charity on 13 June 2014 The company was established under a Memorandum of Association

Governance arrangements

Overall responsibility lies with the directors of the company The number of directors shall not be less than 3, but shall not be subject to any maximum

The directors have the power to appoint any person as a director. One third of directors each year retire on rotation, unless no one is willing to take up office.

All directors are provided with information regarding their responsibilities

Day to day management is delegated to the Centre Manager who is responsible for delivering the work programme, ongoing financial management and human resource matters

Objectives and activities

Aims & Objectives

Northern Hope Gymnastics centre was formed to promote and provide gymnastics for members at all levels and abilities from advanced to foundation level. We provide a high performance gymnastics facility for most British Gymnastics sections, which will include General Gymnastics, Woman's Artistic, Acrobatics, Tumbling, team gym, adults and Pre-School. This we hope will be a good benefit for the inhabitants of Birtley/Gateshead and the surrounding areas. Together with the promotion of community participation in healthy recreation by the provision of facilities of Gymnastics.

The Northern Hope Centre is home to the Northern Hope Gymnastics Club which was opened on 6th July 2013 by David Marshall (British Gymnastics) and Neil Weatherly (Councillor)

Our inspired Gymnastic facility is one of the largest and best equipped training venue in the North of England Our aim is to provide a safe and challenging environment for gymnastics at all levels

Heading our team is Lynn Hope (director/centre manager) senior performance coach in Sports Acrobatics, Women's Artistic, Pre-School, disabilities and general pre-school tutor and assessor. Lynn is supported by a strong and dedicated team of highly qualified and dedicated experienced coaches

The centre is open 7 days a week with a variety of classes to suit all age groups and abilities including Pre-school, recreational, elite artistic, elite acrobatics/tumbling and team gym

The gym club has produced gymnasts who have qualified for the National Tumbling Competitions and a variety of regional champions throughout the disciplines

At the Northern Hope Centre we believe exercise is important for the future health and well being of our children. Gymnastics will promote determination, drive, discipline and dedication but above all in our centre gymnastics is fun whilst personal skills i.e. sharing, working together, and team works as well as equal opportunity are paramount

Our Mission

Northern Hope Gymnastics Centre is committed to the provision of quality facilities and development of gymnastics development in the Birtley/Gateshead and surrounding areas. The Gymnastics Club provides opportunities for all abilities from recreational classes, improver classes and advanced/elite classes.

We also provide opportunities for coach education throughout the North of England through various courses and seminars

We hold various charity events on a yearly basis to enhance the sharing and working together within the community

Achievements and performance

This year we have enrolled in the British Gymnastics 'l'm in' programme which we hope will enhance our disabilities activities. We have also took on board 'My Leadership Academy' this programme introduces young adults to the opportunities within the world of Gymnastics. This programme has involved our 13 to 18 years old gymnasts into community learning delivered through the sport providing an opportunity to engage in this facility and develop new skills in coaching, self confidence and communication

Our specific aims were

- → Develop older gymnasts into coaching
- ♣ Support the gymnasts in identifying their next steps in their gymnastics venture
- → Provide sustainable opportunities to keep them within the sporting world

The trustees are responsible for keeping proper accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the charity and enable them to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Charities Act 1993 and the charity (Accounts and Reports) Regulation 2008 They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the charity and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud or other irregularities
