# INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT TO CONCEPTA DIAGNOSTICS LIMITED UNDER SECTION 449 OF THE COMPANIES ACT 2006

We have examined the abbreviated accounts set out on pages 2 to 4, together with the financial statements of Concepta Diagnostics Limited for the year ended 31 January 2016 prepared under section 396 of the Companies Act 2006.

### Other information

On 1 April 2016 we reported, as auditors of Concepta Diagnostics Limited, to the members on the financial statements prepared under section 396 of the Companies Act 2006 for the year ended 31 January 2016, and our report included the following paragraph:

#### **Emphasis of matter**

In forming our opinion on the financial statements, which is not modified, we have considered the adequacy of the disclosure made in note 1.1 to the financial statements concerning the company's ability to continue as a going concern. The company incurred a net loss of £1,140,735 during the year ended 31 January 2016. At that date, the company had cash resources of £100,389 and net assets of £372,116. However, the sustained losses and the conditions explained in note 1.1 to the financial statements, indicate the existence of a material uncertainty which may cast significant doubt about the company's ability to continue as a going concern. The financial statements do not include the adjustments that would result if the company was unable to continue as a going concern.

# NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 JANUARY 2016

### 1 Accounting policies

### 1.1 Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015).

The directors have reviewed the working capital requirements of the business for the next twelve months. They are confident that based on funding received since the year end from Finance Yorkshire and the pipeline of funding currently in progress, which the directors have assessed as being probably at the balance sheet date, the company has sufficient working capital to meet its obligations as they fall due.

In the event of the immediate funding round being unsuccessful, the directors have made contingencies and plans to ensure that the company's costs are maintained at a minimum as they will continue to seek external funding in order to facilitate the company's plan to get its products to market.

Therefore, for these reasons the accounts have been prepared on the going concern basis.

### 1.2 Compliance with accounting standards

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with applicable United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice), which have been applied consistently (except as otherwise stated).

# 1.3 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows:

Plant and machinery

25% Straight Line

Fixtures, fittings & equipment

25% Straight Line

#### 1.4 Deferred taxation

Deferred taxation is provided in full in respect of taxation deferred by timing differences between the treatment of certain items for taxation and accounting purposes. The deferred tax balance has not been discounted.
