I write in accordance with Rule 18.3 of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016, to provide creditors with a report on the progress of the Administrations of the Companies. This report covers the period from 2 July 2019 to 1 January 2020. This report should be read in conjunction with the Joint Administrators' Statements of Proposals dated 14 December 2015 in respect of each of the Companies and subsequent progress reports dated 8 April 2016, 15 July 2016, 19 January 2017, 21 July 2017, 19 January 2018, 13 July 2018, 30 January 2019 and 31 July 2019.

I have included at Appendix 1 the relevant and required statutory information in respect of the Companies.

As detailed later in this report, the Joint Administrators submitted an application to extend the Administrations of the Companies in August 2019. As a result of this application, the Court advised that going forward the Joint Administrators should prepare a consolidated progress report in respect of the Companies. As such, we present below our progress report for the period on this basis. For the avoidance of doubt, any unsecured non-preferential creditor claim remains with the respective individual entities.

# Summary of steps taken during the period covered by this report

### **Extension of the Administrations**

As detailed in our letter, dated 10 October 2019, the Administrations of the Companies have been extended for a period of two years to 16 September 2021, by the order of the court, dated 19 August 2019.



### Services UK

# Transitional Services Agreement ("TSA")

As previously reported, at the date of Administration, Services UK entered into a TSA with certain of the Companies ("the Group TSA") and the Giant group ("the Giant TSA") to support the ongoing progress of the Administrations and solvent winddown respectively. As a result of these TSA's, Services UK has generated a profit of 5% on services provided.

During the period covered by this report, we have taken steps to plan, and effect, certain of the necessary steps required to finalise, and subsequently, formally terminate the Giant TSA. As part of this process undertakings provided to certain remaining contractors have been withdrawn and we are currently undertaking a process of finalising recharges under the Giant TSA. The Giant TSA will be formally terminated following the resolution of these matters.

In addition, the sole remaining employee of Services UK was made redundant in the period.

### Contracting

# Collection of Nigerian debtor balances

During the period covered by this report, the Joint Administrators have continued to seek to obtain the necessary governmental approvals required to access foreign currency markets required and recover the outstanding Nigerian debtor (c.US\$0.8m); and repatriate cash held in Contracting's Nigerian bank account (c.US\$0.8m).

As part of the National Office for Technology Acquisition and Promotion ("the NOTAP") application, a registration fee of N1.25m (c.US\$3.4k) remained outstanding to the Nigerian Government Authority by the Nigerian debtor in order to facilitate the relevant approvals. Following ongoing negotiations, the Nigerian debtor has agreed to remit these funds to the NOTAP for an equivalent reduction in their outstanding debt.

We continue to liaise with the Nigerian debtor and the NOTAP, through our Nigerian agent, to resolve this matter and seek to recover Contracting's Nigerian assets. We are not yet able to comment on the quantum of timing of any future realisations in this regard.

# Chartering

# Third party debtor realisations

During the period covered by this report, the remaining receivable balance of c.US\$1.1m was received from the Brazilian debtor. ABN AMRO Bank N.V., KfW IPEX-Bank and other smaller German and Dutch banks ("the Lenders") have fixed charge security over this debtor balance. The Joint Administrators have retained these funds and will distribute net realisations to the Lenders at the conclusion of the Administration. No further realisations are anticipated in this regard.

As previously reported, during the period of negotiations with the Brazilian debtor, the Joint Administrators utilised the services of a contractor. Under the terms of Chartering's agreement with the contractor, the contractor is due commission based on total value of realisations. An interim commission payment was made in the period in the sum of £115,901 and a final commission payment will be made following the termination of the agents contract which is anticipated to happen shortly.



### **Taxation**

During the period the Joint Administrators have complied with their obligations in relation to the preparation and submissions of the relevant VAT and corporation tax returns.

Time incurred in respect of Equipment, Investments and Ship 1 primarily relate to ongoing case progression and payments under the Group TSA.

# Receipts and payments account

A summary of our receipts and payments ("R&P") accounts for the period from 2 July 2019 to 1 January 2020 is attached at Appendix 2. It does not reflect estimated future realisations or costs.

# Investigations

I can confirm that no investigations were concluded in the period covered by this report and no investigations are ongoing.

# Joint Administrators' remuneration

The statutory provisions relating to remuneration are set out in Part 18 of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016. Further information is given in the Association of Business Recovery Professionals' publication 'A Creditors' Guide to Administrators' Fees' a copy of which may be accessed from the web site of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales at <a href="https://www.icaew.com/en/technical/insolvency/creditors-guides">https://www.icaew.com/en/technical/insolvency/creditors-guides</a> or is available in hard copy upon written request to me. Please note that the references in the Guide to fee estimates do not apply to Administrations, such as this one, which started before 1 October 2015.

In certain circumstances, creditors are entitled to request further information about our remuneration or expenses, or to apply to court if they consider the costs to be excessive (Rules 18.9 and 18.34 of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016). Further information is provided in 'A Creditors' Guide to Administrators' Fees' referred to above.

The Joint Administrators' remuneration has been fixed by reference to the time properly spent by the Administrators and their staff in attending to matters arising in the Administration by a resolution of the creditors passed on 22 December 2015.

During the period covered by this report, the Joint Administrators have incurred total time-costs in respect of the Companies in the sum of £115,482, as summarised below. In addition, £156,558 has been billed and paid, which partly relates to the prior period. During the period covered by this report, the Joint Administrators have incurred expenses totalling £1,071, which partly relates to the prior period.

### Asset realisations

### Services UK

Payments on account in the sum of £13,925 have been received from Ceona PTE in line with the Giant TSA. Profit totalled £444 in this regard. Further payments on account have been received in respect of the Group TSA in the sum of £2,276.

# Ship 1

Foreign exchange gains in the sum of £1,476 were generated in the period of this report and relate to Ship 1 drawing down on Lender funds utilised by the Companies to support the Administrations.

# Chartering

Debtor realisations in the sum of £762,061 were received in the reporting period, being the outstanding Brazilian debtor balance recoverable. No further realisations are anticipated in this regard.

### Equipment

The Company received £4,044 in relation to drawdown funds from Ship 1 to contribute to costs incurred in the Administration and which are being met by the Lenders. These includes costs related to legal fees and certain Joint Administrators' fees.

### Bank interest

Bank interest totalling £7,018 was received by the Companies during the reporting period. Individual breakdowns are included in the respective R&P's at Appendix 2.

# **Expenses of the Administrations**

During the period covered by this report, we have incurred expenses, excluding Joint Administrators fees, totalling £226,916 plus VAT. At Appendix 4 to this report there is an analysis of expenses incurred by the Joint Administrators and their staff.

### Services UK

As discussed earlier in this report, the final remaining employee of Services UK was made redundant in the period. An expense of £121,499 was incurred in relation to this employee's final salary payment and consisted of gross wages, employee expenses, pension contributions and relevant taxes.

Costs incurred in respect of the Giant TSA, and which were met by Services UK totalled £8,885. These principally relate to contractor costs, employers NIC and benefits of the final Services UK employee. Contractor costs totalling £18,881 were incurred during the period and are fully rechargeable to the Giant group.

Sundry expenses totalling £1,754 were incurred during the period, relating to insurance and ongoing storage charges.

# Chartering

A payment of £77,374 was made to the contractor that assisted in recovering the Brazilian debtor, being monies that are due under the agreed commission structure. A final payment is anticipated to be made shortly under this agreement.



# Ship 1

Funding in the sum of £14,157 was provided to Equipment in line with the Lender fee agreement and the Group TSA to meet certain of the Joint Administrators fees.

# The Group TSA

Costs in respect of the Group TSA totalled £942 during the period which principally relate to legal fees incurred in respect of the Administrations extension costs that were billed in the period after the Administration extensions were granted. Profit in respect of the Group's TSA totalled £48.

# Other expenses

Direct legal fees and expenses in the sum of £2,356 were incurred during the period which principally relate to legal fees relating to the Administrations extensions that were billed in the period after the extensions of the Administrations were granted.

Bank charges totalling £748 were incurred during the period.

For individual breakdowns of the above charges in individual company estates please refer to Appendix 2.

# Remaining work

### Chartering

We will shortly finalise and agree a remaining payment in respect of the commission agreement entered into for the recovery of the Brazilian debtor. A final distribution to the Lenders under their fixed charge will be undertaken at the conclusion of the Administration.

# Services

Prior to the closure of the Administration, the Group TSA and the Giant TSA will be finalised and terminated and final balances agreed.

# Contracting

The Joint Administrators' will, via their Nigerian agent, continue to seek to obtain the necessary approvals from the NOTAP to facilitate the repatriation of cash balances in the sum of US\$0.8m and the recovery of outstanding debtor balances totalling US\$0.8m.

# Final distribution to unsecured non preferential creditors

In addition to the outstanding matters highlighted above, there remain intercompany receivable balances outstanding between the Companies and across the wider Ceona group which form an unsecured non-preferential claim in those Administrations. The recovery of these amounts is dependent on the resolution of the outstanding matters detailed above in order to facilitate a final distribution of net realisations to unsecured non preferential creditors or the Companies in the Administrations.

As outlined, the Joint Administrators anticipate that a final dividend will be declared to the unsecured non-preferential creditors and paid in the Administrations.

### **Next report**

The Joint Administrators will report to you on the conclusion of the Administrations, or in six months' time, whichever is sooner.
