NORTHERN STAR MARINE LIMITED NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS YEAR ENDED 31st MAY 2015

1. Accounting policies

a) Convention

These accounts have been prepared in accordance with the historical cost convention and the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

b) Revenue recognition

Revenue is recognised on the completion of the boat survey. All the turnover is to customers within the United Kingdom.

c) Intangible fixed assets and amortisation

Goodwill is the difference between amounts paid on the acquisition of a business and the fair value of the separable net assets. It is amortised to the profit and loss account over its estimated economic life of five years.

d) Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost of fixed assets, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives on the following basis:

20% reducing balance basis

e) Deferred taxation

The charge for taxation takes into account taxation deferred as a result of timing differences between the treatment of certain items for taxation and accounting purposes. In general, deferred taxation is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date. However, deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that the directors consider that it is more likely than not that they will be recovered against the reversal of deferred tax liabilities or other future taxable profits. Deferred taxation is measured on a non-discounted basis at the average tax rates that would apply when the timing differences are expected to reverse, based on tax rates and laws that have been enacted by the balance sheet date.
