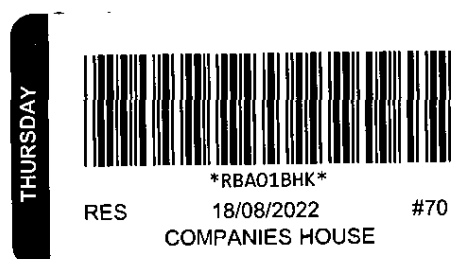
UPON THE APPLICATION by a Claim Form dated 30 June 2022 of the Health and Safety Executive the Claimant and a person with a legal claim against the above named Amianto Limited (hereinafter called "the Company") under section 1029 (2) (f) of the Companies Act 2006

AND UPON READING the evidence

AND IT APPEARING that there is no opposition on behalf of Her Majesty to the relief sought by this Claim as appears from the evidence of service of Peter Hayes and the exhibit thereto

AND the Claimant by its solicitors undertaking to inform the Registrar of Companies immediately on the conclusion of the prosecution proceedings issued under Claim Number T20210426 charging the Company with alleged breaches under Sections 2(1) and 3(1) of the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 insofar as it is against the Company arising out of the alleged unsafe removal of asbestos from a large industrial estate in Stretford, referred to in paragraph 3 to 9 of the Witness Statement of Peter Hayes dated 28 June 2022 or of any appeal therefrom or on the conclusion of the Claimants claim against the Company if by any other means

AND UPON the Solicitors for the Claimant and for the Registrar of Companies (the Defendant) both consenting to this Order

**IT IS ORDERED THAT**

1. The name of the above named Amianto Limited be restored to the Register of Companies
2. If at the time of registration of this Order with the Registrar of Companies, the name of the Company is not available the Registrar of Companies shall pursuant to Section 1033(2)(a)(ii) and (b) of the Companies Act 2006 change the name of the Company to 08634297 Limited
3. An Office Copy of the Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to the above-mentioned Act the Company is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off
4. The Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in her official name in the 'London Gazette'
5. The Claimant do pay to the Registrar of Companies her costs of the said Application in the agreed sum of £300-00
